

**ORDER 2015-35**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION**  
**CONCERNING THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM**  
**CASE NO. VEP-15-35**

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. On or about March 10, 2011, John Doe #35 submitted an application to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") to participate in the Voluntary Exclusion Program ("VEP") for a lifetime exclusion.

2. A VEP participant is not permitted to enter the gaming area of a casino. 68 Ind. Admin. Cod § 6-3-2(f)(1).

3. In the event a participant violates the terms of the VEP, he must forfeit any money or thing of value won from or owed to the participant as the result of a wager at a casino. 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 6-3-2(g).

4. On or about March 8, 2015, John Doe #35 was discovered at Caesars Riverboat Casino, LLC d/b/a Horseshoe Southern Indiana, and had won \$1,500 in cash equivalents.

5. John Doe #35 refused to forfeit the monies as required by Commission regulations and left the property.


Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **ORDERS** John Doe #35 to remit the winnings to the Indiana Gaming Commission as required by the terms of the VEP.
