

ORDER 2015-66
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
REGARDING THE COMMISSION'S CLAIM AGAINST
4 CHAMPS PROMOTIONS, LLC'S SURETY BOND

On November 18, 2014, the Commission issued a promoter's license (license no. BP000011) to 4 Champs Promotions, LLC ("Promoter"), under which it conducted a professional boxing event on November 22, 2014, in Indianapolis, Indiana. As required by Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32(b) and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24-3-13, Promoter obtained a surety bond in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) conditioned upon the payment of all financial and tax obligations pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32.

Pursuant to Section 5 of Resolution 2010-127, the recovery of required payments through the exercise of the promoter's bond must be approved by the Commission. Although some payments have been made, Promoter has failed to make all payments required by Ind. Code § 4-33-22 and 68 Ind. Admin. Code §§ 24-3-27, 24-3-16, 24-3-13, and 24-3-2. The Commission's records reflect that Promoter owes the Commission a total amount of Three Thousand Six Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3,611.50) for unpaid reimbursement fees; unpaid ticket taxes; unpaid boxer licensing fees; and an unpaid boxer's prize purse.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-33-22 and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24, the Commission hereby finds that Promoter has failed to perform its payment obligations by failing to provide payment of the required financial and tax obligations as described above and **APPROVES** the recovery of the required payments in the amount of Three Thousand Six Hundred Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3,611.50) through the exercise of the Promoter's bond.


