

ORDER 2016-066
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
REGARDING THE COMMISSION'S CLAIM AGAINST
HOC PROMOTIONS, LLC'S SURETY BOND

On November 5, 2015, the Commission issued promoter's license number BP000014 to HOC Promotions, LLC ("Promoter"), under which it conducted a pro-am boxing event on December 5, 2015 at House of Champions Fitness Center – Indianapolis, Indiana. As required by Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32(b) and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24-3-13, Promoter obtained a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000 conditioned upon payment of all financial and tax obligations under Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32.

Promoter has failed to make any required payments under Ind. Code § 4-33-22, 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24-3-27, and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24-3-16. The Commission's records reflect that the Promoter continues to owe the Commission a total amount of \$869.50 for unpaid reimbursement fees (\$307.00) and unpaid ticket taxes (\$562.50). Under Section 5 of Resolution 2010-127, the recovery of required payments through the exercise of the promoter's surety bond must be approved by the Commission.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-33-22 and 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 24, the Commission hereby finds that by failing to provide payment of required financial and tax obligations as described above, Promoter has failed to provide part of its payment obligations and **APPROVES** the recovery of the required payments in the amount of \$869.50 through the exercise of the Promoter's bond.


