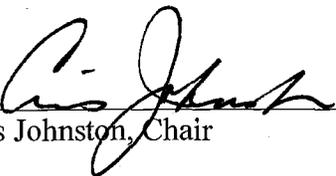
After having reviewed the attached Settlement Agreement, the Indiana Gaming Commission hereby:

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) by and through its Executive Director Sara Gonso Tait and Indiana Gaming Company, LLC. (“Hollywood”) (collectively, the “Parties”), desire to settle this matter prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. 68 IAC 1-5-1(10) states a casino or supplier licensee shall provide written notice to the executive director as soon as the casino or supplier licensee becomes aware of apparent criminal activity taking place at the casino. A casino licensee shall submit the notice required under this subdivision to a gaming agent in addition to submitting it to the executive director.
2. On March 25, 2016 a Gaming Agent was investigating a theft and discovered that an altercation had occurred between two men involved in the investigation. One of the men had punched the other man in the face while on the casino floor. The altercation was observed by a Cocktail Server who failed to notify the Gaming Agents of the battery.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff alleges that the acts or omissions of Hollywood by and through its agents as described herein constitute a breach of IC 4-33, 68 IAC and/or Hollywood’s approved internal control procedures. The Commission and Hollywood hereby agree to a monetary settlement of the alleged violations described herein in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against Hollywood. This agreement is being entered into to avoid the potential expense and inconvenience of disciplinary action.

Hollywood shall pay to the Commission a sum of \$1,500 in consideration for the Commission foregoing disciplinary action based on the facts specifically described in each count of this agreement. This agreement extends only to those violations and findings of fact,

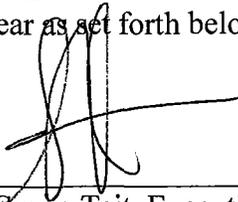
specifically alleged herein. If the Commission subsequently discovers facts that give rise to additional or separate violations, which are not described herein, the Commission may pursue disciplinary action for such violations even if the subsequent violations are similar or related to an incident described herein.

Upon execution and approval of this Settlement Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Commission, Hollywood agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$1,500 and shall waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Settlement Agreement. This Settlement Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Settlement Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Hollywood.
