

ORDER 2016-167
IN RE APPEAL OF ORDER 2015-24 REGARDING THE REMITTANCE OF
WINNINGS BY VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM PARTICIPANT
JOHN DOE #15-24

On March 19, 2015, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved Order 2015-24 remitting VEP participant John Doe #15-24's Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) winnings pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 6-3-2(g).

On April 22, 2015, John Doe #15-24 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2015-24. Administrative Law Judge Gordon White was assigned to the case. Following a hearing on this matter, in which John Doe #15-24 participated, Administrative Law Judge Gordon White issued his Confidential Order, upholding the remittance of the winnings in Order 2015-24.


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:
