

ORDER 2016-231
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #16-73

On May 19, 2016, in Order 2016-111, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of \$1,000.00 from John Doe #16-73 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #16-73 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #16-73 timely filed an appeal of Order 2016-111. On October 26, 2016, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #16-73.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.


