

ORDER 2016-232
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING
AMIE TRAN'S PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE EXCLUSION LIST

On March 22, 2016, Amie Tran ("Tran") was observed via video surveillance at Indiana Grand Casino in Shelbyville, Indiana, taking unlawful possession of another patron's cell phone. Pursuant to 68 IAC 6-1-3, Tran was placed on the statewide exclusion list on April 26, 2016, effectively and permanently barring her from entering any casino in Indiana.

On May 1, 2016, Tran timely filed with the Commission an appeal of her placement on the statewide exclusion list. Administrative Law Judge Donna Stolz Sembroski was assigned to the case. After the Commission filed a motion for summary judgment, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order granting summary judgment and affirming Tran's placement on the statewide exclusion list.

On November 1, 2016, Tran timely objected to the Administrative Law Judge's Order.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. By affirming the Order, the Commission hereby incorporates the findings of fact and conclusions of law in the Administrative Law Judge's Order. This is a final Order of the Commission.
