

ORDER 2017-106
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COMMISSION AND
KAGE CONCEPTS, INC.


The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") hereby issues this Order approving the settlement agreement between Kage Concepts, Inc. and the Commission ("Order"). In support of this Order, the Commission states as follows:

1. The Commission is the Indiana administrative agency, with its principal offices in Marion County, Indiana, that has been granted, in Title 4 of the Indiana Code, the powers and duties to ensure the fairness, integrity and safety of participants in sparring, boxing, and unarmed combat matches or exhibitions in the State of Indiana. Ind. Code § 4-33-22-10.
2. Jennifer Goodman is the owner and operator of Kage Concepts, Inc. ("Sanctioning Body"). On or about October 19, 2016, Kage Concepts, Inc., obtained Sanctioning Body License # SB000009.
3. Sanctioning Body submitted proposed policies to the Commission regarding its procedure for ensuring that no amateur mixed martial arts fighter participates in an event while under suspension in the website registry certified and operated by the Association of Boxing Commissions. Those procedures were approved by the Commission.
4. On March 18, 2017, Sanctioning Body provided oversight of an amateur mixed martial arts event ("Event") hosted by Michiana Fight Club. During that event, amateur mixed martial arts fighter Johnathan Kim was allowed to fight.
5. At the time of the Event, Johnathan Kim was under a suspension ordered by the California State Athletic Commission. That suspension was in the website registry certified and operated by the Association of Boxing Commissions.
6. 68 IAC 24-6-6(f), states that the "failure of a sanctioning body to enforce the policies submitted to and approved by the commission" may result in disciplinary action against the sanctioning body under Ind. Code ch. 4-33-22, Ind. Code art. 4-21.5, and the Commission's rules.
7. In lieu of an administrative action, the Commission offered to settle the matter with Sanctioning Body for a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00 USD).
8. Sanctioning Body, in the interest of resolving the issues in the Commission's letter, has agreed to settle the matter with the Commission.

After reviewing the facts and the terms of the settlement agreement, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** approval of the proposed settlement agreement between the Commission and Sanctioning Body.


