

**ORDER 2017-153**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION**  
**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH DEAVON ROLLEY**


Deavon Rolley (“Licensee”) has held a Level 2 permanent occupational license at the Tropicana Evansville Casino since July 6, 2016, to work as a Cage Cashier. The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) issues occupational licenses to casino employees in positions where interaction with gaming machines is required. On June 20, 2017, Licensee was observed, interacting improperly with the gaming machines in violation of 68 IAC 2-3-9.4.

The Commission is authorized to take action including, but not limited to, revocation, restriction, or suspension of an occupational license at any time the Commission determines that the licensee is in violation of 68 IAC 2-3 or Ind. Code ch. 4-33-8. In lieu of disciplinary action, the Commission has agreed to settle the matter with the Licensee. 68 IAC 13-1-18. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing and, in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid and voluntary relinquishment of Licensee’s occupational license and identification badge for a period of seven (7) regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation time or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
