

**ORDER 2017-154**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE**  
**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THOMAS TOWERY**

Thomas Towery ("Licensee") has held a level 2 occupational license to work at Hollywood Casino as a Dealer since May 16, 2006. On June 15, 2016, Licensee submitted a three year reinvestigation/renewal application to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission"). During the routine background reinvestigation, Commission investigators determined that Licensee had failed to meet the requirements of 68 IAC 2-3-9.


All occupational licensees have a continuing duty to maintain suitability for licensure and must notify the Commission of any changes in the information submitted in the licensee's application or any information that could render the licensee ineligible to hold an occupational license. 68 IAC 2-3-9.

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Licensee have agreed to settle this matter pursuant to 68 IAC 2-3-5(f)(2) and 68 IAC 13-1-18. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid voluntary relinquishment of Licensee's occupational license and identification badge for a period of two regularly scheduled working days, without using any vacation or other paid leave time. As an additional term to the settlement agreement, Licensee agrees to show documentation of compliance with 68 IAC 2-3-5(c)(13).

Having considered the foregoing the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
