

ORDER 2017-174
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION REGARDING THE
COMMISSION'S CLAIM AGAINST DM FIGHT PROMOTIONS' SURETY BOND

DM Fight Promotions ("Promoter") was issued promoter's license # BP000013 on October 14, 2016, under which it conducted a professional boxing event on April 8, 2017, at the Hammond Armory in Hammond, Indiana. As required by Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32(b) and 68 IAC 24-3-13, Promoter obtained a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000 conditioned upon payment of all financial and tax obligations under Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32.

Promoter has failed to make the required payments under Ind. Code § 4-33-22-32, 68 IAC 24-3-27, and 68 IAC 24-3-16. The Commission's records reflect that the Promoter owes the Commission a total of \$837.50 for unpaid reimbursement fees (\$500.00) and unpaid ticket taxes (\$337.50). Pursuant to Section 5 of Resolution 2010-127, the recovery of required payments through exercise of the surety bond must be approved by the Commission.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code ch. 4-33-22 and 68 IAC 24, the Commission hereby finds that by failing to provide payment of required financial and tax obligations as described above, Promoter has failed to meet its payment obligations and **APPROVES** the recovery of the required payments in the amount of \$837.50 through exercise of the Promoter's bond.
