

ORDER 2017-213
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH DANIEL HEAD

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") hereby issues this Order Approving the Settlement Agreement between Commission staff and Daniel Head. In support, the Commission states as follows:

Daniel Head ("Licensee") is a licensed professional mixed martial artist holding fighter's license #PM000022. The license was issued on June 3, 2017.

On June 3, 2017, Licensee participated in a professional mixed martial arts bout in Kokomo, IN hosted by Colosseum Combat. Pursuant to 68 IAC 24-3-37, Licensee submitted to a drug test immediately following the bout. Thereafter, Licensee was found to be in violation of 68 IAC 24-3-37.

The Commission is authorized to take action, including but not limited to, revocation, suspension, denial, or restriction of license if the Licensee is determined to be in violation of Ind. Code ch. 4-33-22 or 68 IAC 24. 68 IAC 24-2-5.

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Licensee have agreed to settle this matter pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that the Licensee agrees to a fine of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) in exchange for the Commission's agreement not to pursue further disciplinary action in relation to this incident. Subsequently, Commission staff and the Licensee agreed on a settlement of this matter and entered into the Settlement Agreement, effective September 22, 2017.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the Settlement Agreement.
