

ORDER 2017-216
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING
THE PAID FANTASY SPORTS OPERATOR LICENSE OF
YAHOO FANTASY SPORTS, LLC.

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code art. 4-33, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) has completed its background and financial investigation of Yahoo Fantasy Sports, LLC (“Yahoo”) and has determined that Yahoo is suitable to hold a paid fantasy sports game operator’s license (“game operator license”).

The issuance of an operator’s license is conditioned upon the following:

1. Full compliance with all relevant emergency rules, orders, and resolutions issued by the Commission;
2. Continued satisfaction of all requirements set forth in Ind. Code ch. 4-33-24; and
3. Submission of all necessary requests for annual renewal of the operator’s license pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-17 along with timely payment of the annual renewal fee pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-15.

The Commission has determined that Yahoo is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-33 and is suitable to hold a game operator’s license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a game operator’s license to Yahoo for a period of one year beginning November 16, 2017 through November 15, 2018.
