AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE CONFIDENTIAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE
APPEAL OF THE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #16-10


On February 24, 2016, in Order 2016-10, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of One Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$1,360.00) from John Doe #16-10 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #16-10 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the French Lick Casino in French Lick, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #16-10 timely filed an appeal of Order 2016-10. On November 15, 2016, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #16-10. On November 16, 2016, the ALJ issued an Order approving the confidential settlement agreement.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the confidential settlement agreement.
