

ORDER 2017-61
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAM KAMERY

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) hereby issues this Order Approving the Settlement Agreement between Commission staff and William Kamery (“Order”). In support of this Order, the Commission states as follows:

William “Bill” Kamery (“Licensee”) is a licensed professional mixed martial artist from Marion, Iowa. On or about November 5, 2016, Licensee renewed professional mixed martial artist license #PM000716. The license is set to expire on September 30, 2017.

On November 5, 2016, Licensee participated in a championship professional mixed martial arts bout at Hoosier Fight Club in Hammond, Indiana. Pursuant to 68 IAC 24-3-37, Licensee submitted to a drug test immediately following the bout. Thereafter, Licensee was found to be in violation of 68 IAC 24-3-37.

Commission staff contacted Licensee regarding the violation and agreed to settle this matter, in lieu of disciplinary action against Licensee, for a fine of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). Subsequently, Commission staff and the Licensee agreed on a settlement of this matter and entered into the Settlement Agreement, effective January 17, 2017.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the Settlement Agreement.
