

ORDER 2017-84
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH LUCAS VEGA

Lucas Vega (“Licensee”) has held a Level 2 permanent occupational license at the Hollywood Casino since June 10, 2015, and has worked as a Dual/Rate Dealer and Table Games Supervisor since November 15, 2016. The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) issues occupational licenses to casino employees in positions where interaction with gaming machines is required. On January 21, 2017, Licensee was observed acting in violation of 68 IAC 2-3-9.4.

The Commission is authorized to take action including, but not limited to, revocation, restriction, or suspension of an occupational license at any time the Commission determines that the licensee is in violation of 68 IAC 2-3 or Ind. Code ch. 4-33-8. In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and the Licensee have agreed to settle this matter pursuant to 68 IAC 2-3-5(f)(2) and 68 IAC 13-1-18.

The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing and, in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid and voluntary relinquishment of Licensee’s occupational license and identification badge for a period of seven (7) regularly scheduled working days, without using any vacation time or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
