

ORDER 2018-141

AN ORDER APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP IN NRT TECHNOLOGY CORP. AND NAME CHANGE TO NRT SIGHTLINE CORP.

Under 68 IAC 5-2, supplier licensees that are private companies must comply with certain requirements before transferring an ownership interest.

The proposed transfer of ownership involves the merger of businesses by NRT Technology Corp. ("NRT") and Sightline Payments LLC ("Sightline"). NRT is a current supplier licensee in good standing, having its license most recently renewed on June 23, 2018, pursuant to Order 2018-85. As a result of this merger transaction, NRT will have new ownership and will change its name to NRT Sightline Corp. ("Transaction"). Meanwhile, Sightline will become a subsidiary of NRT Sightline Corp. and convert to a corporation under the name NRT Sightline, Inc.

In accordance with and subject to Indiana Code chapters 4-33-7 and 4-35-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Commission has completed its background and financial investigation of NRT Sightline, Corp. ("Applicant") and has determined that the Applicant is substantially compliant with Indiana statutes and regulations, and thus satisfies the requirements for a transfer of ownership under 68 IAC 5-2.


In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed transfer of ownership interest in NRT Technology Corp. and the subsequent name change to NRT Sightline Corp, subject to the following conditions:

1. This Order shall be effective when Applicant, or any substantial owners, key persons, or other persons deemed necessary by the Commission receive approval from all regulatory jurisdictions that require approval for the Transaction to close.
2. If the Applicant, or any substantial owners, key persons, or other persons deemed necessary by the Commission fail to receive required approvals from other regulatory jurisdictions to act in their capacity as outlined in the Indiana application, this Order may be subject to further consideration.
3. Conditions imposed by other jurisdictions on Applicant, or any substantial owners, key persons, or other persons deemed necessary by the Commission shall require written notification to the Executive Director within ten (10) days of receipt of such conditions.
4. Not addressed in this Order are any occupational licensing decisions that would dictate the authority or control by individuals following closure of this transaction. Occupational licensing determinations are made and issued by the Executive Director at or around the time of closing.
