

ORDER 2018-194

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #17-79**


On November 16, 2017, in Order 2017-185, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved the remittance of Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy dollars (\$3,770.00) from John Doe #17-79 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #17-79 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #17-79 timely filed an appeal of Order 2017-185. Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #17-79, and on October 15, 2018, Commission staff and John Doe #17-79 fully executed a settlement agreement.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.


