

ORDER 2018-22
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT ON THE APPEAL OF ANTHONY
CARVER'S PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE EXCLUSION LIST

On November 7, 2017, Anthony Carver was placed on the Statewide Exclusion List. Subsequently, Mr. Carver timely filed an appeal, and Deputy Attorney General Gordon White was appointed as Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") in this matter.

Pursuant to its authority in 68 IAC 7-1-15, Commission staff entered into settlement discussions with Mr. Carver. On January 23, 2018, Mr. Carver and the Commission agreed to settlement terms which affirmed Mr. Carver's placement on the Commission Exclusion List, but allow Mr. Carver to petition for removal from the Exclusion List twelve months from the date he was placed on the list. On February 4, 2018, the ALJ issued an order approving the settlement agreement.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with 68 IAC 7-1-15, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's order approving the settlement agreement. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen days after it is served.
