

ORDER 2019-154

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH RONALD JARVIS**

Ronald Jarvis ("Licensee") currently holds an occupational license to work at Hoosier Park Racing and Casino as an Electronic Games Floor Attendant. Licensee has held the occupational license since December 3, 2018. Licensee was observed assisting a patron in wagering and gambling games, in violation of 68 IAC 2-3-9.3.

The Commission may take action including, but not limited to, revocation, suspension, or restriction of a permanent occupational license at any time for violation of 68 IAC 2-3 or Ind. Code ch. 4-33-8. 68 IAC 2-3-10. In addition to disciplinary action, the Commission is also authorized to make a settlement offer at any time prior to the final disposition of an action against the license. 68 IAC 13-1-18.


In lieu of an administrative proceeding regarding Licensee's occupational license due to Licensee's failure to adhere to occupational licensee rules, Commission staff offered to settle the matter if Licensee agreed to an unpaid voluntary relinquishment of his license and identification badge for a period of ten (10) regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
