

**ORDER 2019-76**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION**  
**REGARDING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN**  
**THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND DORIS WEBSTER**

On December 7, 2018, Executive Director Sara Tait, pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 6-1-3(2), placed Doris Webster (“Webster”) on the Commission’s lifetime Exclusion List, which barred her entrance to any casino or gambling game facility located at a racetrack in Indiana.

On December 26, 2018, the Commission received Webster’s request for a hearing regarding her placement on the Exclusion List. On February 21, 2019, a Prehearing Conference was held wherein the administrative law judge gave the Parties time to conduct settlement discussions.

In lieu of further administrative proceedings, Commission staff offered to settle the matter if Webster agreed to remain the exclusion list until August 1, 2019, twelve months from the date she inappropriately claimed a jackpot at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino in Anderson, Indiana.


Webster agreed to the settlement terms offered by Commission staff.


Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
