

RESOLUTION 2020-85

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AUTHORITY TO APPROVE VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM FORFEITURES:

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to authority granted to it under Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-35 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6. The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-3-18, the Commission may by resolution assign to the executive director any duty imposed upon the commission by this article.
2. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-4-3(a)(9) the Commission adopted rules to establish and implement a voluntary exclusion program ("VEP") that met the requirements of subsection (c).
3. Pursuant to 68 IAC 6-3-3, the executive director or his or her designee shall administer the VEP, which shall contain the names and personal information of all voluntarily excluded persons.
4. Pursuant to 68 IAC 6-3-2(g) a voluntarily excluded person who enters the gaming area of a casino agrees to forfeit any jackpot or thing of value won as a result of a wager made at a casino. The forfeited jackpot or items will be withheld by the casino licensee and remitted to the commission.
5. Due to the high volume and frequency of VEP forfeitures and the length of time between Commission meetings, it would be more efficient and in the best interest of the Commission to delegate the authority to the Executive Director to approve VEP forfeitures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to all members of the VEP, potential members, Riverboat Owner licensees, Racetrack Gambling Game Licensees, Operating Agents, Certificate Holders, and all entities that become such licensees at a later date.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

The definitions set forth in Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-35 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR APPROVAL OF VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION PROGRAM FORFEITURES.

Due to the high volume and frequency of VEP forfeitures and the length of time between Commission meetings, the Commission hereby delegates the authority to the Executive Director the authority to approve VEP forfeitures.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution is effective immediately.


