Re: Eligible Counties for Annual Activity License – Civic Two (2) Year

Pursuant to I.C. 4-32.3-4-5.5, a civic organization may apply for a two-year license to conduct annual casino game night activities if it is located in a county where not more than three (3) qualified organizations possess an annual casino (or charity) game night license. Accordingly, eligible qualified civic organizations located in the following counties, pursuant to statutory requirements, may submit an application:

Additional Reminders:

- The application period will be open to and including September 30, 2021. Thereafter, if more than one (1) otherwise qualified bona fide civic organization has applied for a two-year license in a particular county, the Commission may hold a random drawing to determine which organization to award the license.
- Qualified civic organizations must submit the following forms to apply: Application for Annual Activity License (Form CG-AL), including Schedules A, B, and C, and Qualification Application (Form CG-QA) if the organization has not received notice from the Indiana Gaming Commission in the preceding three years that it has been deemed to be a qualified organization. - All successful applicants are to comply with all elements of the statute (4-32.3-4-5.5) and Emergency Rule Section 22, including the yearly financial reports and payment of fees.
