

ORDER 2022-196
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION PROSPECTIVELY RENEWING
THE CASINO OWNER'S LICENSE CDITH, LLC d/b/a QUEEN OF TERRE HAUTE CASINO
RESORT

In accordance with Ind. Code art. 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") issued a permanent casino owner's license to CDITH, LLC d/b/a Queen of Terre Haute Casino Resort ("CDITH") by order 2021-229, effective December 27, 2021. This is Churchill Downs' first license renewal.

On December 5, 2022, CDITH requested renewal of its casino owner's license and submitted the required annual renewal payment in the amount of \$5,000.


COMMISSION ACTION

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-6-12, the Commission found that CDITH substantially complied with the requirements set forth in Ind. Code art. 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code; therefore, CDITH is suitable to hold a casino owner's license. The Commission **GRANTS** renewal of CDITH's casino owner's license for a period of one year subject to CDITH maintaining its casino gambling operation, riverboat, hotel, and pavilion in substantial compliance with all applicable state and local laws, including but not limited to, Commission regulations, resolutions, orders, and/or other directives relating to the casino owner's license or the lawful conduct or operation of gaming in Indiana. The renewal of the casino owner's license is valid for a period of one year from December 21, 2022, through December 20, 2023.


According to Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-3, this Order is effective fifteen days after it is served.
