SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") by and through its Executive Director Greg Small and Majestic Star Casino, LLC d/b/a Hard Rock Casino Northern Indiana ("Hard Rock"), (collectively, the "Parties") desire to enter into this settlement agreement ("Agreement") prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. 68 IAC 6-3-4(b)(3) requires internal controls for refusing wagers from and denying gaming privileges to any voluntarily excluded person.
- 2. 68 IAC 6-3-4(e)(3) provides a casino licensee shall be subject to disciplinary action under 68 IAC 13 for failure to comply with the requirements of this section and the internal control procedures outlined under this section, including, but not limited to, failure to follow internal control procedures adopted under this rule.
- 3. Hard Rock's approved internal control procedures, A-2, describe the procedures for the Voluntary Exclusion Program ("VEP").
- 4. On December 11, 2022, Gaming Agents performed a VEP audit for October 2022. The results of the audit determined that one (1) VEP had two (2) accounts. One (1) of the accounts was not properly flagged.
- 5. On December 22, 2022, Security notified Gaming Agents that they had received a report that a VEP was on property attempting to obtain a cash advance. A review of surveillance coverage determined that upon entering the casino, the VEP played at a table game and then was observed at a kiosk. The VEP then proceeded to the Cage and received a \$1,000 cash advance. The VEP left the casino and returned a few hours later. The VEP is observed gaming and then, ultimately gets identified when he attempts to obtain a second cash advance.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff alleges that the acts or omissions of Hard Rock by and through its agents as described herein constitute a breach of IC 4-33, IC 4-38, 68 IAC, and/or Hard Rock's

approved internal control procedures. The Commission and Hard Rock hereby agree to a monetary settlement of the alleged violations described herein in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against Hard Rock.

Hard Rock shall pay to the Commission a total of \$7,500 in consideration for the Commission foregoing disciplinary action based on the facts specifically described in the Findings of Fact contained in this Agreement. This Agreement extends only to those violations and findings of fact specifically alleged in the findings above. If the Commission subsequently discovers facts that give rise to additional or separate violations, the Commission may pursue disciplinary action for such violations even if the subsequent violations are similar or related to an incident described in the findings above.

Upon execution and approval of this Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Agreement by the Commission, Hard Rock agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$7,500 and waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Agreement. This Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original agreement and both of which shall constitute one and the same agreement. The counterparts of this Agreement may be executed and delivered by electronic mail, facsimile, or other electronic signature by either of the parties and the receiving party may rely on the receipt of such document so executed and delivered electronically as if the original had been received.

This Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Hard Rock.
