

Waiver Summary

Commission Meeting

All Casinos:

- Granted a multitude of waivers due to the casino closure during the Covid-19 pandemic. 68 IAC 2-6-6(b), 68 IAC 3-3-6, 68 IAC 11-9-3, 68 IAC 15-3-3, 68 IAC 15-4-3(5), 68 IAC 15-5, 68 IAC 15-6, 68 IAC 15-8-1, 68 IAC 16-1, 68 IAC 2-2-8, 68 IAC 2-3-8, 68 IAC 2-3-9.1 and 68 IAC 2-3-9.2.

American Gaming Association:

- Granted a waiver allowing a five calendar day shipping notice for electronic gaming devices and live gaming devices. 68 IAC 14-3-10(a), 68 IAC 17-1-2(a) and 68 IAC 17-2-2(a).

Ameristar Casino:

- Granted a waiver for coin testing during a slot reconfiguration project. 68 IAC 2-6-6(c)(5)(B).

Belterra Casino:

- Granted a waiver for the staffing on the bill validator drop for sports wagering kiosks. 24-Hour Gaming Operations Plan.
- Granted a waiver for New Year's Eve performers to forego wearing a vendor's badge. 68 IAC 15-6-4(d).
- Granted a waiver to use a modified Craps table. 68 IAC 10-4-1.

Caesars Southern Indiana:

- Granted a waiver allowing the collection of poker tip boxes once a week. 68 IAC 15-9-3(a).
- Granted a waiver allowing the position of Executive Steward to be moved from a Level 3 to Non-Gaming position. 68 IAC 2-3-1(f).
- Granted a waiver allowing thirty four minors to participate in the Kentucky Derby Festival Fashion Show in the Showroom. 68 IAC 1-11-1(c).
- Granted a waiver allowing two minors to be in attendance at the IUS Medallian Awards Event in the Event Center. 68 IAC 1-11-1(c).
- Granted a waiver allowing two minors to be in attendance at a Rauch Event in the Event Center. 68 IAC 1-11-1(c).

French Lick Casino:

- Granted a waiver on table game drop boxes to remove shift information from drop box and allow the use of an imprinted label on the drop box. 68 IAC 14-2-2(a)(1)(F).

Hollywood Casino:

- Granted a waiver for the staffing on the bill validator drop. 24-Hour Gaming Operations Plan.
- Granted a waiver to use a promotional fund tube at poker tables to color up \$1 chips to \$5 chips. Poker Room Promotional Fund Memo.
- Granted an ongoing waiver to use RFID playing cards during the Heartland Poker Tour events. 68 IAC 2-2-1(c)(2)(C) and 68 IAC 2-7-2(a).
- Granted a waiver to use a modified Craps table. 68 IAC 10-4-1.

Harrah's Hoosier Park & Indiana Grand:

- Granted a waiver allowing patrons to alter, mark, ben or deface playing cards at baccarat and baccarat variations. 68 IAC 10-10-10(c).

Horseshoe Hammond:

- Granted a waiver for the use of a \$100,000 tournament chip. 68 IAC 14-4-5(b) and 68 IAC 14-4-4(a)(5).
- Granted a waiver for the staffing on the bill validator drop for the sports wagering kiosks and the location of the count for the sports wagering kiosks. 68 IAC 11-3-6 & 24-Hour Gaming Operations Plan.
- Granted a waiver allowing a portion of blackjack dealer training to be in a live gaming pit on the casino floor. 68 IAC 2-5-4(b)(3).
- Granted a waiver on the security escort for the poker bank replenishment. 68 IAC 15-10-5(5).
- Granted a waiver for two minors to participate in a Hoosier Fight Club Event in The Venue. 68 IAC 1-11-1(c).

Indiana Grand:

- Granted a one-time waiver to destroy playing cards off-site due to the large volume of cards needing to be cancelled and destroyed. 68 IAC 14-3-4(d) and 68 IAC 12-1-5(b)(4).

Majestic Star:

- Granted a waiver to utilize a token tube to convert tips of smaller denominations into fewer chips of larger denominations. 68 IAC 15-9-1(d)(4).

Tropicana Evansville:

- Granted a waiver for non-gaming and under 21 employees to work an event in a temporary gaming space. 68 IAC 2-3-1(c)(1).
