

ORDER 2018-119

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
REGARDING BLUE CHIP CASINO, LLC'S REQUEST TO MOVE
CERTAIN ELECTRONIC GAMING DEVICES INLAND
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE § 4-33-6-24**

House Enrolled Act 1540, which went into effect on July 1, 2015, contains a provision that allows casino owner's licensees to submit a plan to the Commission to allow docked riverboat casinos to relocate inland.

In order to relocate inland, a casino owner's licensee must satisfy a number of conditions. First, the casino must be located on property that the casino owner's licensee owned or leased and used in the conduct of gaming operations on February 1, 2015. Second, the new inland casino must be located on property adjacent to the riverboat dock site. Third, the casino must comply with all building codes and safety requirements imposed by the Commission. Fourth, the Commission must approve relocation. Ind. Code § 4-33-6-24(b). Finally, the number of gambling games to be offered at the inland casino cannot exceed the greatest number of gambling games the casino owner's licensee offered at the docked riverboat casino since January 1, 2007. Ind. Code § 4-33-6-24(e).

On May 10, 2018, Blue Chip Casino, LLC ("Blue Chip") submitted its request to relocate certain Electronic Gaming Devices ("EGDs") operations from its docked riverboat casino inland to its existing sports bar: The Game. Specifically, Blue Chip requests the Commission's permission to install bar-top video poker machines in the bar area of The Game. The Game is a 21 and over facility and is located adjacent to the riverboat dock site on land that Blue Chip has owned and used to conduct gambling operations since February 1, 2015. Blue Chip's proposal will not cause it to exceed the greatest number of gambling games the casino owner's licensee offered at the docked riverboat casino since January 1, 2007.

COMMISSION ACTION


The Commission hereby **APPROVES** the request submitted by Blue Chip to relocate certain EGDs from the docked riverboat casino inland, subject to the conditions that follow.

The Commission's approval of request is conditioned upon Blue Chip: (1) meeting all conditions contained in Ind. Code § 4-33-6-24(b); (2) meeting the condition contained in Ind. Code § 4-33-6-24(e); (3) meeting any other requirement imposed by the Commission pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-6-24(d); and (4) receiving plan approval, which approval authority the Commission delegates to the Executive Director.
