Mr. Embrey was appointed to the Commission as Chairman in September of 2025 to September 2029.

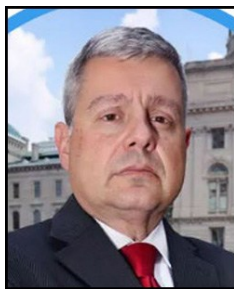
Troy Helman (Vice Chairman)

She was previously appointed by IL Governor Bruce Rauner to lead one of the nation's largest public lottery organizations where she managed a multibillion-dollar budget and negotiated the termination of a failed private management agreement. She has also served as Deputy Mayor and Chief of Staff for the City of Gary, overseeing all city functions, policies, and projects, and later as the Executive Director of the Gary/Chicago International Airport, where she negotiated the large-scale relocation of three Class I railroads to enable completion of the airport's \$200 million runway expansion.

Statewide casino revenues declined by 0.61%, from \$2.33 billion to \$2.32 billion in FY 26. Casino wagering taxes for FY 26 were \$582.9 million, which was a 1.41% increase over FY 25. Supplemental taxes for FY 26 totaled \$47.7 million, down 4.41% from FY 25. Year over year, wagering taxes were up \$8.1 million and supplemental taxes were down -\$2.2 million.

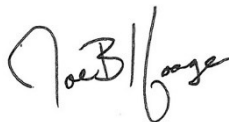
The total statewide casino win was \$2.44 billion, down 0.85% from \$2.46 billion the fiscal year prior. The Northern Indiana market saw a 4.22% decrease to \$942.0 million. The racinos also experienced a 2.63% increase to \$595.2 million. While the southern Indiana market realized a 0.61% increase to \$899.4 million.

Sports wagering taxes were up 11.64%, from \$49.1 million in FY 25 to \$54.9 million in FY 26. During FY 26, handle, or total amount wagered, equaled \$5.77 billion, an approximate increase of \$255 million. Online wagers accounted for 98% of all wagers made in FY 26.

Passed during the 2026 legislative session, Public Law 77 authorized the licensing of a new inland casino in either Allen, DeKalb, or Steuben County, subject to voter approval. Upon successful passage of a public referendum in November, casino operators can submit applications to the Commission for potential licensing. The Commission will then review all eligible applications and make a final determination on any approval by April 15, 2027.

Veteran and fraternal charitable groups began offering electronic pull tabs in early 2026, pursuant to Public Law 74 enacted following the 2025 legislative session. The new games quickly gained popularity, generating over \$46M in net statewide revenue in FY 26.

FY 2026 TAX OVERVIEW

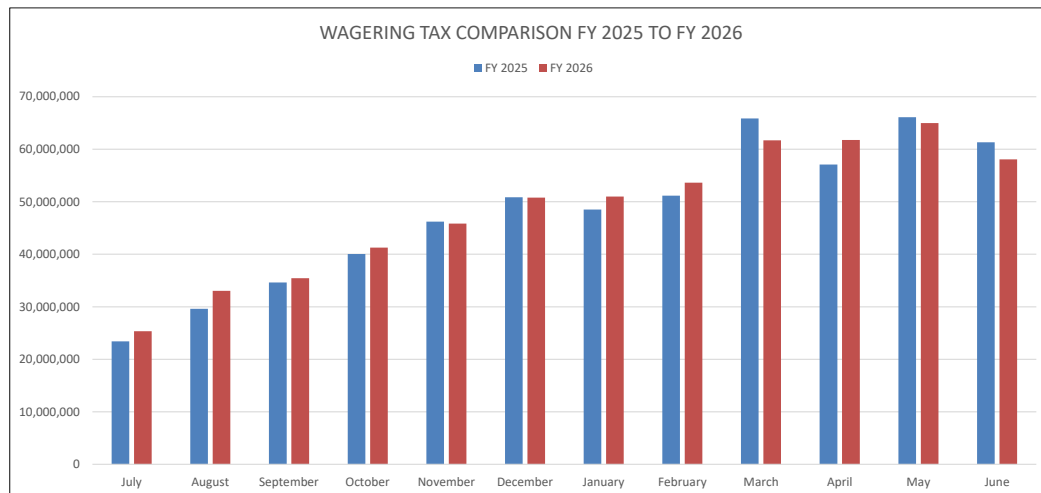
In FY2025, gaming and sports wagering operations in Indiana generated **\$582,901,831** in wagering tax, **\$47,669,982** in supplemental wagering tax, and **\$54,858,098** in sports wagering tax for a total of **\$685,429,911**. As of June 30, 2026, **\$19,301,619,421** in Wagering, Supplemental Wagering, and Sports Wagering Tax had been reported since inception.

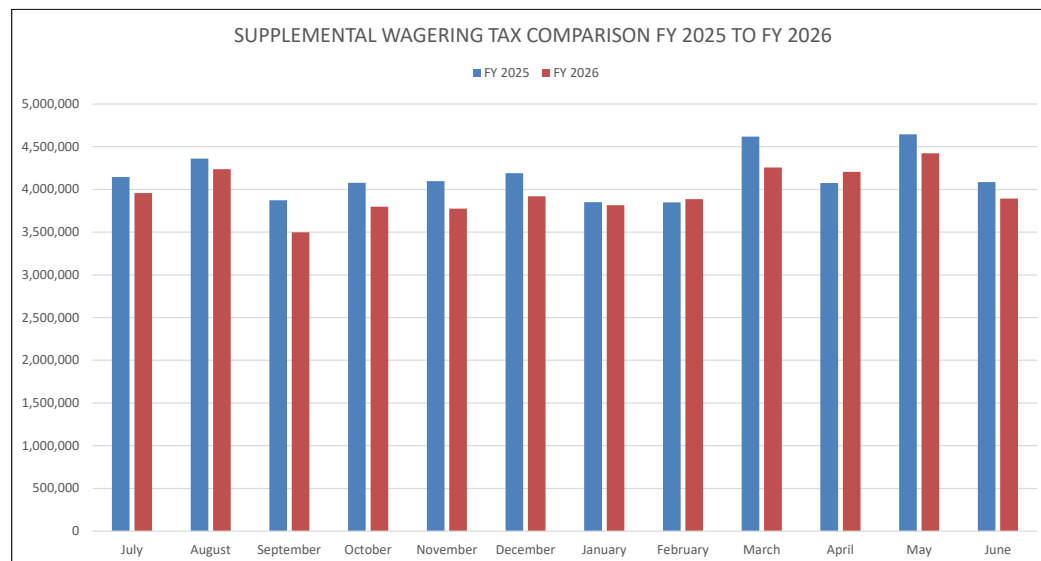

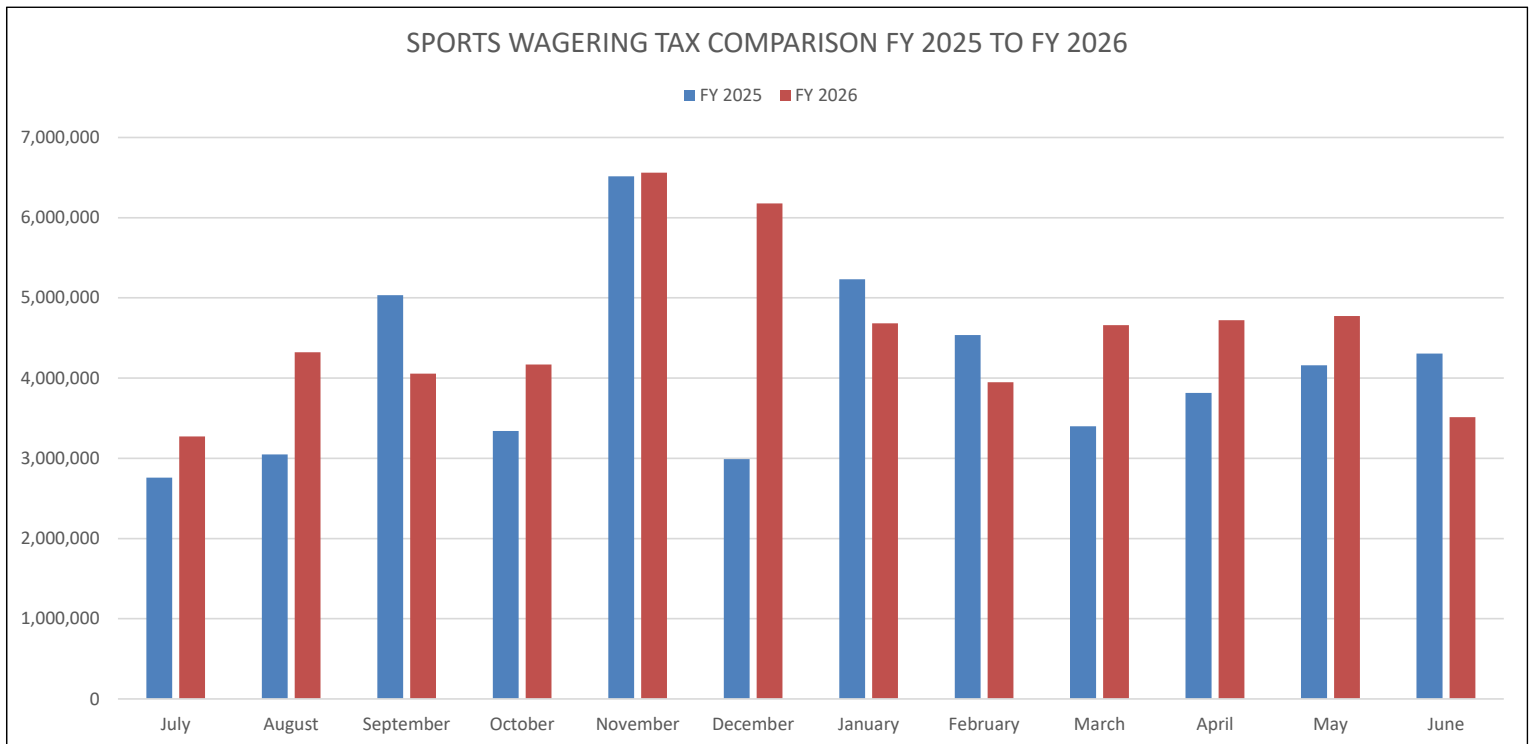

MBE/WBE UTILIZATION

Disparity Study

Statute requires the Commission to establish annual goals for the use of minority and women-owned enterprises (M/WBE). These goals must be derived from a statistical analysis of utilization study of casino contracting and purchases. Such an analysis, also called a disparity study, must be updated every five years.

In keeping with its statutory mandate, an update of the Commission's study was completed in November 2022. The Indiana University Public Policy Institute completed the study on our behalf, examining the contracting and purchasing practices of Indiana's casinos from 2017 through 2022. Based upon actual purchase data provided by the casinos and audited by Commission staff, the study period reviewed over \$1.7 billion in spending on goods and services.

In addition to a review of purchasing, also called utilization, a disparity study must also seek to establish capacity, which is a measure of all firms ready, willing, and able to provide goods and services to Indiana's riverboat casinos. The capacity estimate derived from the study is below.

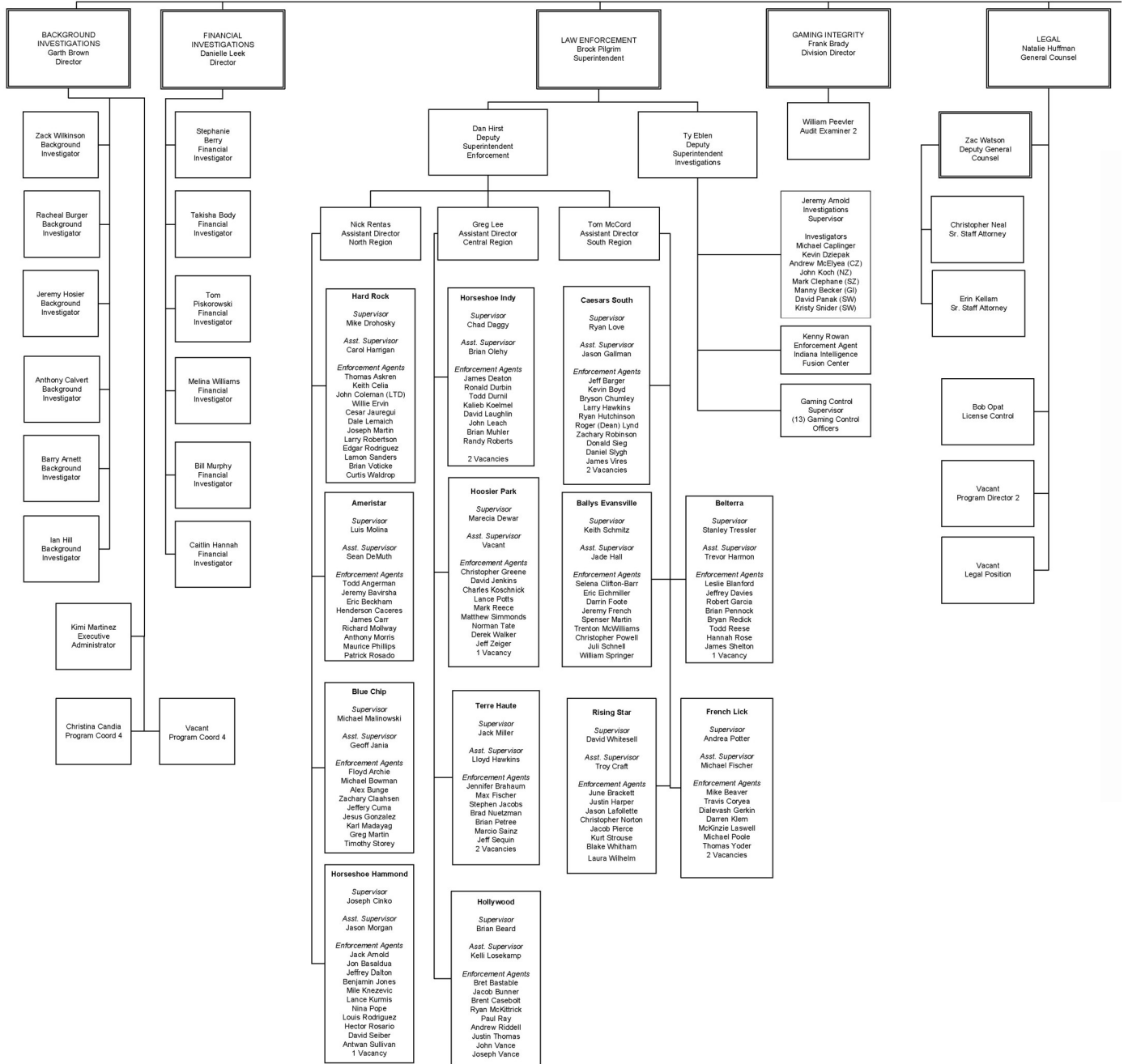

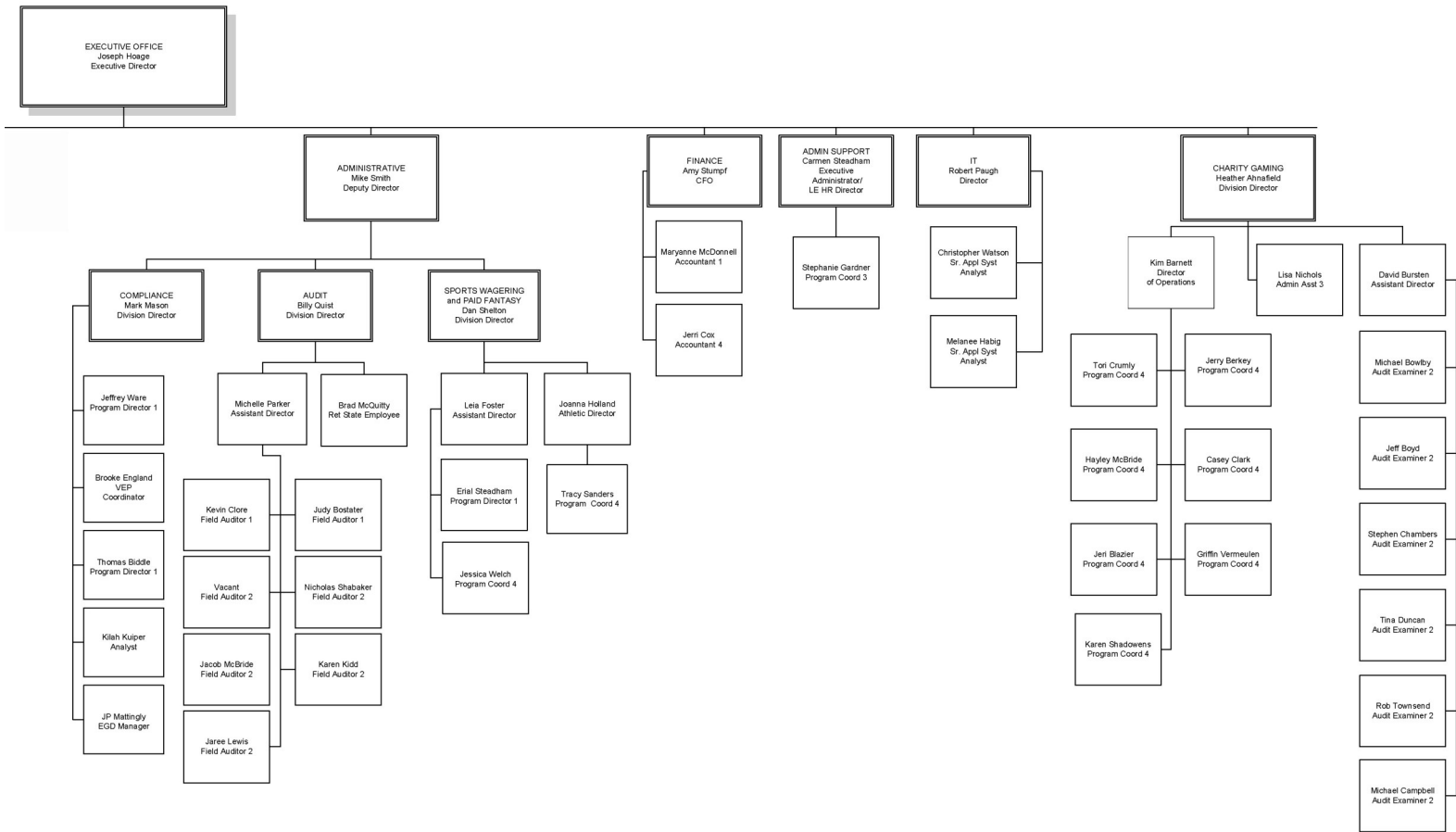

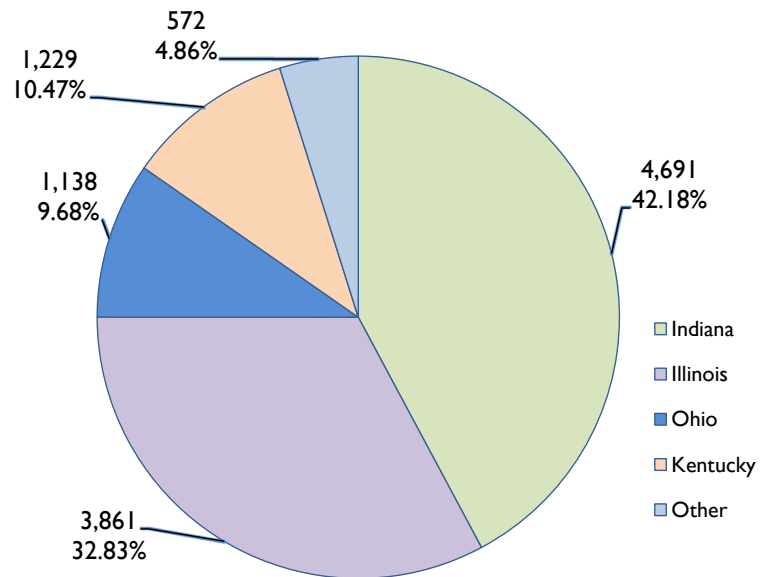
VEP Statistics

There were 6,929 active members from forty (40) different states in the Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP) as of June 30, 2026. 4,886 members were previously enrolled for a one or five year term, and have since removed themselves from the VEP, for a total of 11,815 enrollments over the life of the program. In fiscal year 2026, sixty-three (63) forfeitures were approved by the Commission, and resulted in approximately \$96,599.89 in forfeitures.

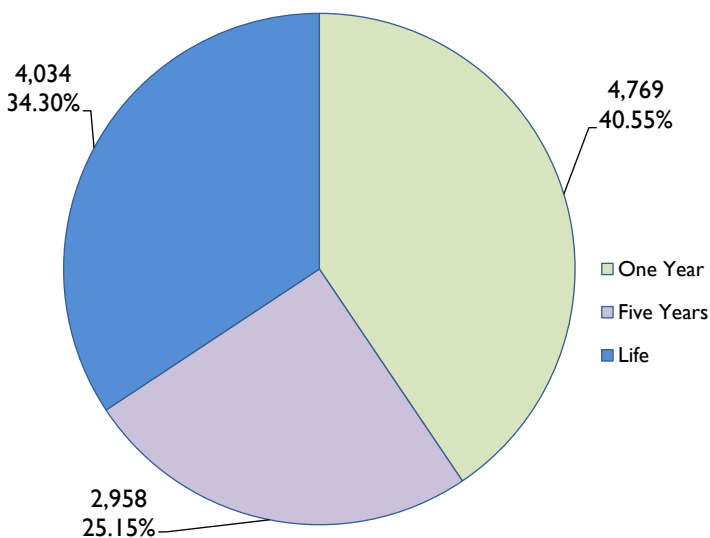
Member Gender



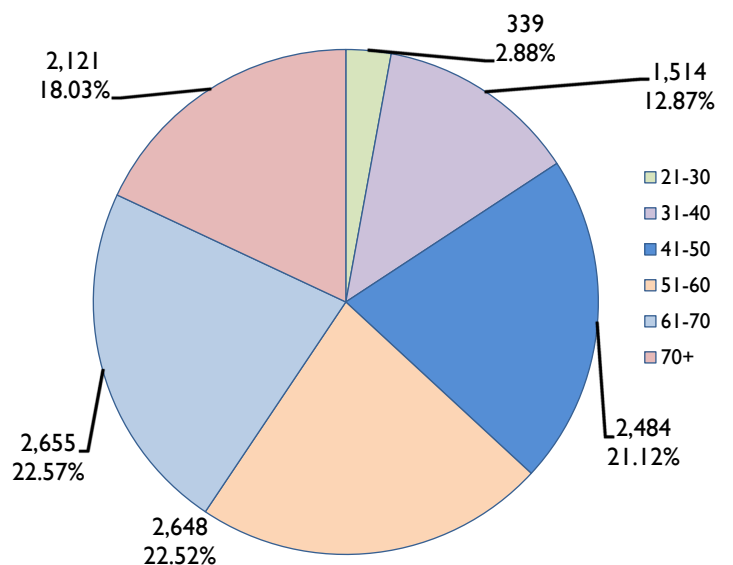
Member State



Member Exclusion Length



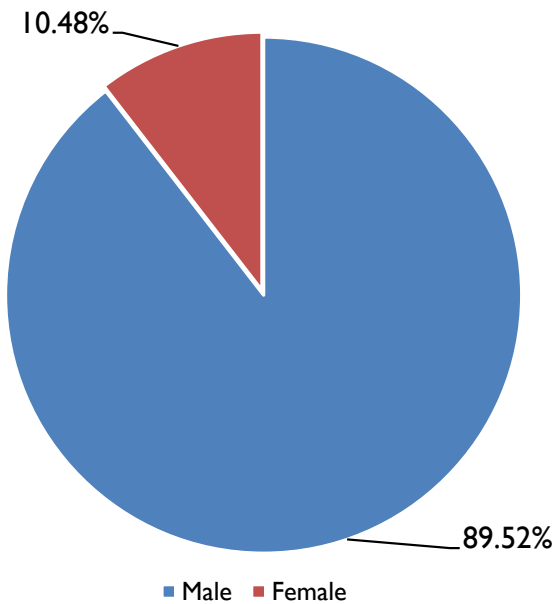

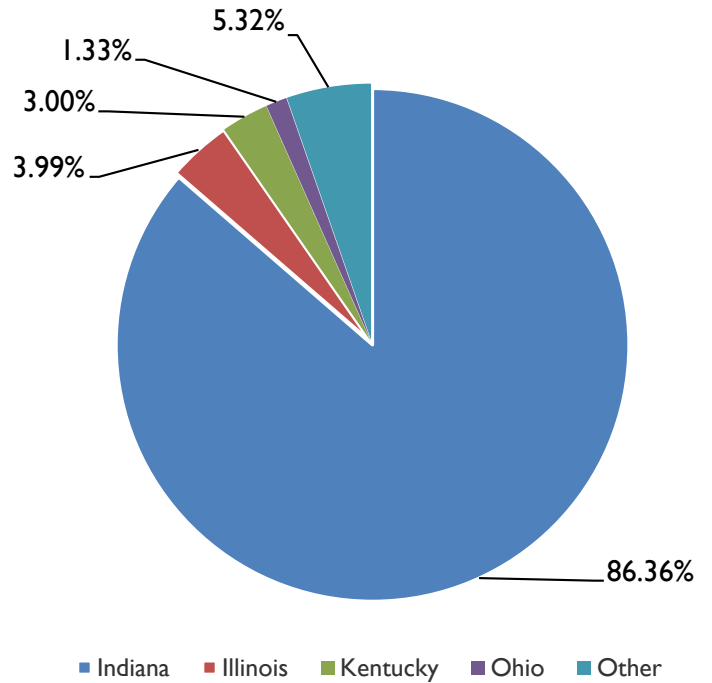
ISRP Statistics

Pursuant to Indiana Code 4-38, the Internet Self-Restriction Program (ISRP) was implemented on September 1, 2019. ISRP only applies to mobile sports wagering. Mobile sports wagering is defined as sports wagering conducted through computers or mobile or interactive devices and accepted in the state of Indiana through an online sports wagering system approved by the IGC. To date, six hundred one (601) individuals have signed up for ISRP; with ninety-two (92) individuals removing themselves, bringing the active total enrollments to five hundred nine (509). The graphs here display the program participants, as categorized by age, gender, home state and length of exclusion.

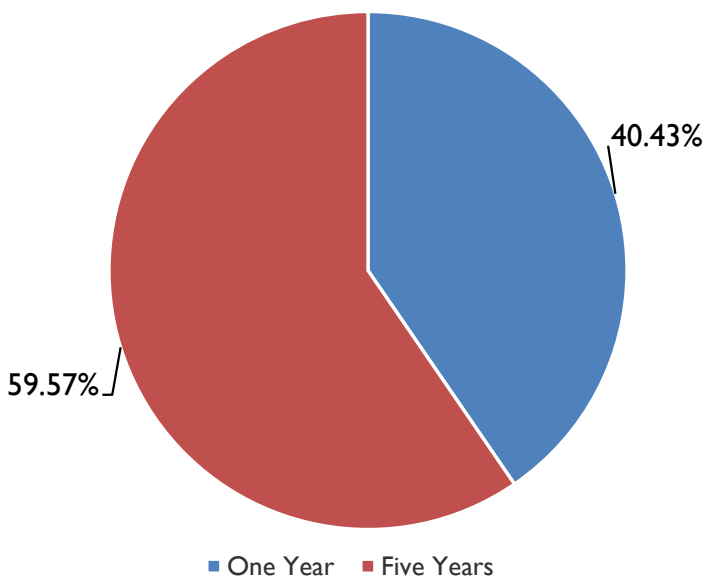
Member Gender



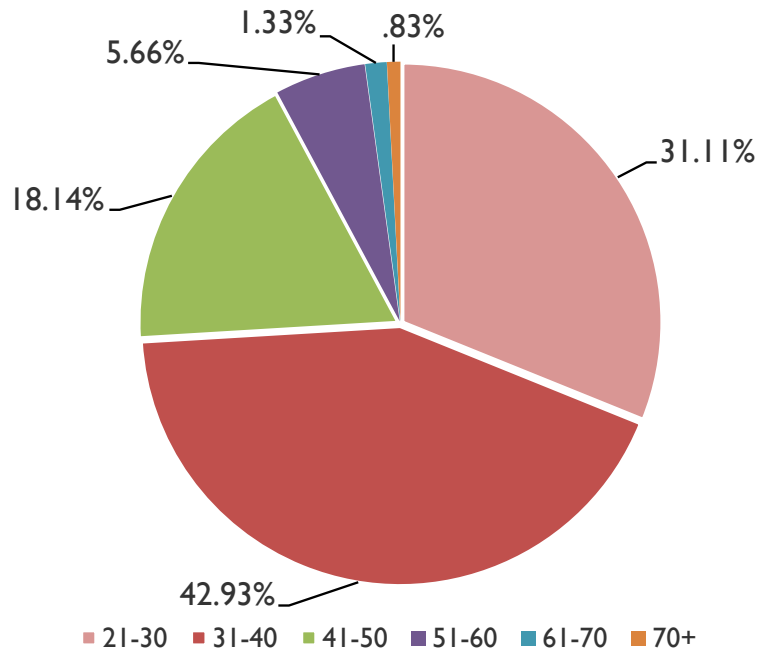
Member State
