**Re: Request for Project Applications for FY 2026 Continuum of Care Funding**

On behalf of the Indiana Balance of State Continuum of Care (“IN BoS CoC”), the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (“IHCDA”) is releasing requests for project applications to be included in the Collaborative Application for the FY 2026 Continuum of Care Notice of Funding Opportunity.

The Continuum of Care (CoC) Program (24 CFR part 578) is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development through a national competition between geographic areas designed to:

- Promote a community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness;
- Provide funding for efforts by nonprofit providers, states, local governments, and Indian Tribes or tribally designated housing entities
- Rehouse quickly homeless individuals, families, persons fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking, and youth while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused by homelessness;
- Promote access to and effective utilization of mainstream programs and programs funded with State or local resources; and
- Optimize self-sufficiency among homeless individuals and families.

As the IN BoS CoC Collaborative Applicant, IHCDA is seeking both renewal and new project applications through its annual Internal Competition for permanent housing, transitional housing, and supportive services.

IHCDA recommends that anyone interested in applying review the Internal Competition Policies and application materials on the IN BoS CoC’s [Internal Competition](#) webpage. Application links can be found there as well.

**Applications for both renewal and new applications must be submitted electronically via the Electronic Application forms and received by IHCDA no later than July 17, 2026, at 5:00 PM ET.**
