

To: All RHTC Development Partners Notice: RED-23-19 From: Real Estate Department Date: May 11, 2023 Re: Updated Data, Scoring, and Instructions for Opportunity Index and Housing Need Index

<u>Part I</u>. According to the 2023-2024 QAP (p. 70), there are seven points possible, one point per factor, in the Opportunity Index. For maps, scoring, data, and explanation for six of these factors, please follow this link: <u>QAP Index Scoring Maps</u>.

<u>Part II</u>. According to the 2023-2024 QAP (p. 75) Housing Need Index – Population Growth will be calculated using the latest available data. When such data comes available, IHCDA will utilize that data and will announce the change to our partners via a RED Notice.

This RED Notice serves to announce new data - that an application will earn one point if it is in a county having experienced population growth of at least 5% between 2010 and <u>2020</u> and having experienced positive net growth between <u>2021</u> and <u>2022</u>.

<u>Part III</u>. According to the QAP (p. 76), Schedule L will provide lists and instructions for determining qualifications for points in the Housing Need Index categories.
