WHAT IS CSBG?

- **Federally-funded block grant** from the Office of Community Services, Administration for Children and Families, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
- Awarded to states, territories and tribes.
- Supports services that **alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty nationwide.**

WHAT DOES CSBG DO?

Funds services and activities primarily through Community Action Agencies (CAAs) including housing, nutrition, utility, and transportation assistance; employment, education, and other income and asset building services; crisis and emergency services; and community asset building initiatives.

In 2021, through CSBG funds...

- **219,462 individuals** in **112,059 households** were served statewide.
- **1,572 nonprofits** and **3,450 for-profit businesses** served as partners.
- **\$600,000** was issued for COVID-19 Impact Grants to further support the community.
