Subject: ASHRAE 62.2 Compliance Procedures Using the Red Calculator

Beginning July 1, 2026, all Indiana WAP audits performed on or after July 1 must use the Red Calculator in LITT/WAPLink to document ASHRAE 62.2 compliance. This requirement aligns with WPN ventilation guidance and SWS standards and supports consistent documentation across Subgrantees.

Purpose

To establish a consistent procedure for documenting ASHRAE 62.2 ventilation requirements in WAP using the Red Calculator in LITT/WAPLink.

Requirement

Effective July 1, 2026, all ASHRAE 62.2 calculations for audits performed on or after July 1 must be completed using the Red Calculator within LITT/WAPLink. It replaces prior versions, spreadsheets, and external tools as the only approved tool for Indiana WAP.

Audits conducted before July 1 may retain the calculator used at the time of audit. Audits conducted on or after July 1 must use the Red Calculator in LITT/WAPLink.

Access to the new Red Calc screen in LITT/WAPLink is based on the audit date found on the job overview page in WA 10 settings, not the audit run date.

The app may be used in the field, but the same values must be entered into the ASHRAE 62.2 module in LITT/WAPLink for official documentation.

Compliance Standards

WPN guidance requires Grantees and Subgrantees to follow ASHRAE 62.2-2016, or the version adopted by the State Plan; use approved tools; and maintain documentation showing compliance with whole-building and local ventilation requirements.

SWS requires ventilation systems to meet ASHRAE 62.2 requirements including calculated and measured airflow, document final compliance and use consistent, accurate Grantee-approved tools.

Failure to use the Red Calculator for audits performed on or after July 1 will result in monitoring findings/Concerns and may require file correction.
