Subject: Revised Training Requirements regarding OSHA 10 and Wx Manager training.

BACKGROUND

IHCDA is revising policy in the 2025 Wx manual regarding training guidelines, specifically OSHA 10 and Wx Manager training requirements.

- IHCDA is removing the requirement for all weatherization professionals to successfully complete OSHA 10 and
- the requirement for all new weatherization program managers to complete a Program Management class from a WAP Training Provider

OLD POLICY

- Subrecipient staff and contractors working in weatherization units are trained on how to adhere to safe work practices ensuring adherence to the following, but not limited to, EPA, OSHA, 29 CFR 1910 and 29 CFR 1926. Subrecipient must ensure Wx staff are provided with and trained on the use of appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) per appropriate OSHA and CFRs regulations/laws as applicable.
- All weatherization professionals working in Indiana Weatherization are required to successfully complete OSHA 10. All new Weatherization Program Managers must complete a Program Management class from a WAP Training Provider

NEW GUIDANCE

- Subrecipient staff and contractors working in weatherization units must adhere to safe work
 practices including appropriate use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and safety procedures
 per OSHA and applicable regulations/laws including, but not limited to, EPA, OSHA, <u>29 CFR 1910</u>
 and <u>29 CFR 1926</u>.
- 2. Subrecipients are no longer required to follow language from the manual stating:
 - a. "All weatherization professionals working in Indiana Weatherization are required to successfully complete OSHA 10.
 - b. All new Weatherization Program Managers must complete a Program Management class from a WAP Training Provider"
