Step 1

Verbal questions by a 138 RTI medic will be asked prior to the student being allowed access to the RTI.

If the student is considered "high risk" or "symptomatic" they will not enter the RTI. Return to HOR or quarantine

Step 3

- Cadre will perform daily monitoring of students
- ONLY If the trainee is considered "high risk" or "symptomatic" will the RTI RAPID TEST and quarantine procedures take place.

Step 4

- Monitor throughout training
- **ONLY** if the trainee is considered "high risk" or "symptomatic" will a **RAPID TEST and QUARANTINE** procedures take place
- Follow protocols for testing (warranted/available?) positive cases will go into quarantine
