- 2. If you have any questions concerning the use of any products or aids, ask your TAC Officer. If you are not authorized to use an item, it does not mean that you must throw it away. Storage locations are available. Coordinate with your TAC Officer(s) to place all unauthorized items (except for flammables) in the security room or class amnesty box.
  - Tobacco products
  - Vaping products
  - Cap stiffeners
  - Civilian clothes (secured in storage area)
  - Commercial cleaners and waxes (not issued by supply)
  - Computer (to include PDA/pocket PC/tablet)
  - Performance enhancing and weight loss dietary supplements
  - Correction tape or fluid
  - Alcohol
  - Knife with a blade more than four inches
  - Pornography
  - Personal weapons
  - Smart watches, glasses, or other items that will provide a communication advantage or GPS capability (other than cellphone, that will be locked away other than authorized usage times).
