The Hoosier Youth ChalleNGe Academy (HYCA) Candidate Packing List listed below is the minimum required clothing and personal items allowed for the Residential Phase. <u>Candidates must arrive with these items.</u>

DO NOT WEAR OR BRING watches, jewelry of ANY kind, hats, sun glasses, wallets, cell phones, video games, MP3 players or any musical devices. Religious medallions are acceptable; however, the chain or beads must be of a length that allows for the article to be worn under t-shirts.

If something is not on the list to bring - DO NOT bring it!

Candidates must arrive with the following items:

There will be an inspection of these items during In-Processing and any unauthorized items will be placed in storage and returned at Home Pass. Packing list items should be double bagged in clear garbage bags to prevent spillage. Please include one additional clear trash bag as a backup. (NOTE: Clear trash bags can be found at Home Depot or Lowes.)

In-Processing Day Appearance for Males:

- 1. Males should arrive with a military style burr hair cut
- 2. A white polo or button down shirt with a collar should be worn.
- 3. Blue jeans without holes and with belt loops, no skinny jeans, should be worn.
- 4. A belt should be worn properly.
- 5. Black socks and appropriate under garments should be worn.
- 6. Candidates should arrive wearing one pair of running or cross trainer athletic shoes. **NOTE:** These athletic shoes will be worn daily. We encourage you to have a good pair of athletic shoes for Physical Training (PT).

Male Cadet Clothing List:

- 1. _____7 Pair COTTON Boxer Shorts or Boxer Briefs: Brown, Black or any solid color.
- 2. _____ 10 Pair Black Socks (must be at least calf length, no ankle socks).
- 3. _____ 6 plain white t-shirts (package of men's short sleeve crewneck undershirts)
- 4. _____ Any sporting medical equipment, such as: knee/ankle/wrist brace or wraps, as needed.

Personal Items Common to All Candidates:

- 1. _____ Four 4x6 photos (Limited to immediate family and/or children).
- 2. _____ Address Book with family and friends addresses and phone numbers already entered. Please place Candidates name on the inside cover.
- 3. _____ Sketch pads and colored pencils are optional. These items are for use in limited personal time and will not conflict with instruction of any kind. Please ensure these items are clearly labeled with the Candidates first and last name.

Each Candidate is required to bring with them a minimum of the following personal hygiene items: (Please place these in a separate baggie)

- 9. _____ Shaving cream or foam (No gel for shaving faces or after shave. Bump cream as needed.)
- 10. ____ Chap stick
- 11. _____ Disposable plastic razors
- 12. _____ Pocket-size Kleenex packs
- 13. ____ Contact Lens Users: A 3 month supply of disposable, extended wear contacts and solution, plus one pair of prescription glasses with case.
- 14. _____ Two pair of shoe insoles or gel pads
- 15. _____ One pair of shower shoes
- 16. _____ Three sets of towels and wash cloths. Towels should be 22x44 and needs to be a solid color (black, brown, or gray-ONLY) Wash cloths need to be a solid color (black, brown, or gray-ONLY)
- 17. _____ One pair of slip on tennis shoes, without laces
- 18. _____ Nail Clippers, without the middle file
- 19. ____ Foot Powder

NOTE: Male Candidates who require special care products to meet appearance and hygiene standards must discuss these needs prior to In-Processing Day with the Cadre Supervisor. These standards are very important to the Academy and the intent of this policy is to follow the quasi-military atmosphere.

<u>PARENTS</u>, please keep the following items with you in a separate zip-lock bag to be turned over to the Medical Department's Station during In-Processing:

- 1. Prescription Medications and/or special products (These will be surrendered to the HYCA Medical Team during In-Processing and will be inventoried and administered in accordance to the prescribing Doctor's guidance or under the supervision of the Academy Medical Staff.)
- 2. Prescription Medications must come with, at least, a 30 day supply.
- 3. All OTC (Over the Counter) Medications must come with a 22 ¹/₂ week supply.
- 4. Any special need items sporting medical equipment, such as: knee/ankle/wrist brace or wraps, as needed.

<u>PARENTS</u>, please keep the following items with you in a separate zip-lock bag to turn over to the Letter Writing <u>Station during In-Processing</u>:

- 1. 50-100 stamps for letter writing
 - a. The Administration Office will let you know when your cadet needs more stamps
- Letter from Parent(s)/Guardians Mall Call is vital to the morale of the Candidate/Cadet. Please take a few
 moments and write an encouraging letter or note to your Candidate to be opened on the evening of InProcessing. Parents/Guardians will not be allowed to leave until they have turned in a letter for their Candidate.

PARENTS, CADETS WILL NEED TO RETURN FROM HOME PASS WEARING A WHITE POLO. This will be the outfit that your cadet wears on Graduation Day.
