Even better is now a confirmation appears when people submit their documents via the Box widget and those same applicants will soon receive an email as well confirming the application is in as well. **Reality check: Some people are trying to scam others in SBA's name.** There is no immediate deadline for an EIDL (Economic Injury Disaster Loan) application and it does not cost anything to apply, get the papers together, no credit card is needed, etc. If you get inquiries about this, please help us stop the rumors and tell clients there is absolutely no cost to apply.
