

MOT: Phases for Temporary Pavement

- Need Phase for MOT Pvt
 - No Shoulder Work Adjacent to Live Traffic
 - Must Shift Lanes
- Note a Standard Drawing
 - Only if Appropriate!
- Detail Layout
 - Provide Width for Barrels/Barrier
 - Protect Drop-Offs
 - IHCP Impacts

Accounting for Utility Relocation in Environmental Impacts Environmental Document @ STG2 Relocation Details @ STG3 (2)

Complication:

Standard Spec Requirements for Construction Limits Clearing for Utilities is Project Specific



Solution:

Discuss potential utility relocation areas relative to environmentally sensitive areas at the Preliminary Field Check.

Send Updated Plans to Utilities as additional Environmental Resources are discovered during project development.
