Chris Creighton was appointed INDOT Chief of Staff in June 2021.

Chris has served in Governor Holcomb's office since the beginning of his administration as Deputy Legislative Director from 2017 to 2018 and as State Legislative Director from 2018 to 2021. In these roles, Chris served as one of the Governor's chief lobbyists, policy advisors, and liaisons to the Indiana General Assembly. He also oversaw all executive branch agency legislative efforts. Previous to his service in the Holcomb administration, he was Legislative Director at the Indiana Department of Health under former Health Commissioner and Surgeon General Jerome Adams.

Chris started his career as a Senate Republican Intern during the 2010 legislative session. This opportunity opened doors to do work for the Indiana Republican Party in Communications (2011), the Indiana Senate Majority Campaign Committee as Statewide Field Director and Campaign Manager (2010 and 2011-2012), and Hathaway Strategies as a Project Manager (2013-2016).

Chris is originally from Bremen, IN where he graduated from Bremen High School in 2006. He received his Associate's Degree from Holy Cross College, a Bachelor's Degree from Indiana University-South Bend, and is a 2017 graduate of the Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law. He is licensed to practice law in Indiana.

He is a resident of McCordsville, where he lives with his wife Katie, son Grant, and dog Autry. In his spare time, he enjoys spending time with his family, friends, and rooting on the Notre Dame Fighting Irish.
