The following report is being submitted to the Indiana Historic Bridge Task Group (Task Group) per Stipulation IV.C of the *Programmatic Agreement among the Federal Highway Administration, the Indiana Department of Transportation, the Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Regarding Management and Preservation of Indiana's Historic Bridges* (Historic Bridges PA). Stipulation IV.C states, in part, that "INDOT will prepare an annual report that will include a list of Select and Non-Select Bridges that have been processed during the previous calendar year pursuant to this Agreement and the scope of each project. INDOT will submit this report on or before January 31 of each year to the Task Group."

The information in this report is divided into several categories as outlined below. Several categories beyond the minimum requirement to provide a list of bridges that "have been processed [by INDOT/FHWA] during the previous calendar" are provided to better track and analyze the status of the historic bridge population overall.

The following table lists the bridges for which the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) Cultural Resources Office (CRO) has knowledge of actions occurring from January 2023 through December 2023. Additionally, some other entries are included for actions that took place prior to 2023, but had not yet been captured in an annual report. There is often lag time between when locally funded projects are implemented and bridge inspections are performed, and when that new information is incorporated into INDOT's system. Support documents related to these actions are included in the Attachments portion of the report as appropriate.

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Part II

Part II. Select Bridges that Have Been Replaced or Have an Unknown Status

As outlined in the following table, INDOT-CRO has knowledge of thirty-one (31) Select Bridges that have been removed/replaced or for which their status is unknown.* This list does not include bypassed or relocated structures. Since those structures are still extant, they still retain their Select designation and are listed in other sections of this report.

For the majority of the bridges in this table, they have been demolished. Some have been put into storage with the current status being unknown, and for others their status is simply unknown. For the bridges not in storage with an unknown status, they are no longer being inspected for inclusion in the National Bridge Inventory (NBI) inspection reports submitted to INDOT.

Per Stipulation IV.G. of the Historic Bridges PA (below), when a Select Bridge is demolished with *local* funds, the bridge owner can no longer utilize the streamlining procedures of the Historic Bridge PA on other Select or Non-Select Bridge projects that utilize Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds. Rather, they must follow regular Section 106 procedures pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800 and would require execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to resolve any adverse effects.

Anticipatory Demolition – If FHWA or Indiana SHPO determine a bridge owner intentionally demolishes or otherwise diminishes the historic integrity of a Select Bridge under the bridge owner's jurisdiction with non-Federal-aid funds, then FHWA will comply with 36 CFR Part 800 for any future federal-aid bridge project proposed by that bridge owner. After the next Bridge Survey update is completed in accordance with Stipulation II.C.2, FHWA may process federal-aid projects in accordance with this Agreement for that bridge owner.

While the following list is a list of **all known** Select Bridges that have been removed/replaced, it **does not** automatically constitute a list of bridge owners that are no longer able to utilize the Historic Bridge PA per Stipulation IV.G. Before the environmental process is initiated for any proposed FHWA-funded projects for bridges owned by bridge owners on this list, FHWA and INDOT will need to make an assessment of whether it is appropriate to invoke Stipulation IV.G., and therefore, comply with 36 CFR Part 800 instead of utilizing the Historic Bridge PA process.

Part III. Non-Select Bridges Have Been Replaced or Have an Unknown Status

As outlined in the following table, INDOT-CRO has knowledge of one hundred and twenty-one (121) Non-Select Bridges that have been replaced, are currently proposed for replacement, or for which the status is unknown.* These bridges have been demolished, soon will be demolished, have been put into storage with the current status being unknown, or simply have an unknown status. For the bridges not in storage with an unknown status, they are no longer being inspected for inclusion in the NBI inspection reports submitted to INDOT.

A bridge "proposed for replacement" is not added to this list until the public hearing for the proposed project has been held and certified, per the procedures of the Historic Bridges PA. Until that point, the preferred alternative has not yet been finalized. This list does not include bypassed or relocated structures. Since those structures are still extant, they still retain their Non-Select designation and are listed in other sections of this report.

As outlined in the following table, INDOT-CRO has knowledge of forty (40) Select Bridges and three (3) Non-Select Bridges that are in pedestrian/bicycle use or are slated for future pedestrian use. These bridges have been bypassed or left in place or have been located to a new site for bicycle/pedestrian use. Some of these bridges had already been bypassed or converted to pedestrian use at the initiation of the Historic Bridge Inventory when their original Select/Non-Select designation was given. Others have been bypassed or relocated as the result of projects processed under the Historic Bridges PA. In previous annual reports, these structures were broken down into two groups for reporting purposes: bypassed or relocated. 

Part VI. Tally of Extant Select and Non-Select Bridges

Below is a "running tally" of extant Select and Non-Select bridges compared to the original total of Select and Non-Select Bridges from 2010. For Select bridges to be considered a "loss" in this context, they have been demolished, their original designation was changed to Non-Select or non-historic, and/or they have an unknown status. For Non-Select bridges to be considered a "loss" in this context, they have been demolished, their original designation was changed to non-historic, and/or they have an unknown status. Bridges that are going to be reused on local trail systems, have been bypassed, or have been relocated are not counted as a "loss" in this tally. Non-Select Bridges "proposed for replacement" have been included as a "loss" only after the public hearing for the proposed project has been held, as noted in Part III of this report.

It should be noted that the tally for Select bridges reflects two "gains" since the 2010 list - INDOT Bridge Nos. 135-55-01522B and 163-83-01393A were changed from not NRHP-eligible to Select in 2017 and 2022, respectively.

Since 2010, 93% of the Select Bridges are still extant and 56% of the Non-Select Bridges are still extant.

Dear Mr. Eshelman:

Pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (54 U.S.C. § 306108) and 36 C.F.R. Part 800, the staff of the Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer ("Indiana SHPO") has conducted an analysis of the materials dated and received on February 21, 2023, for the above indicated project in the City of Indianapolis, Wayne Township, Marion County, Indiana.

In terms of impacts of proposed project-related ground-disturbing activities to archaeological resources, based upon the submitted information and the documentation available to the staff of the Indiana SHPO, we have not identified any currently known archaeological resources listed in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places ("NRHP") within the proposed project area. However, this identification is subject to the ground-disturbing project-related activities remaining within areas disturbed by previous construction of a recent and non-historical nature. If archaeological deposits are encountered from the post-contact period, they will be evaluated regarding their eligibility for the NRHP in consultation with the staff of the Indiana SHPO. Please contact our office if such deposits are encountered. The archaeological recording must be done in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's "Standards and Guidelines for Archaeology and Historic Preservation" (48 F.R. 44716) and a report of the archaeological documentation must be submitted to our office for review and comment.

If any prehistoric or historic archaeological artifacts or human remains are uncovered during construction, demolition, or earthmoving activities, state law (Indiana Code 14-21-1-27 and Indiana Code 14-21-1-29) requires that the discovery be reported to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology within two (2) business days. In that event, please call (317) 232-1646. Be advised that adherence to Indiana Code 14-21-1-27 and Indiana Code 14-21-1-29 does not obviate the need to adhere to applicable federal statutes and regulations, including but not limited to 36 C.F.R. Part 800.

In regard to buildings and structures, we have identified the Marion County Bridge Number 2415F (Indiana State Highway Bridge Number 40-49-6215), which carries Washington Street over Little Eagle Creek (HB-2641), within the probable area of potential effects, and we believe that it meets the criteria of eligibility for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places ("NRHP") due to its historical and architectural significance." According to the INDOT Historic Bridge Inventory, this bridge was determined to be "Select" and eligible for the NRHP under Criterion A for its association with "the National Road and development of the state's early 20th century transportation systems."

We have no concerns about the removal of the existing pavement, earth fill, patching on the concrete arch, repointing of stone masonry joints, or replacement of curbs and sidewalk. In regard to the bridge railing, we understand that it is unknown what

the historic railing type was prior to its replacement with metal railing. We wish to point out that, in our office's Historic Bridge survey records available on the State Historic Architectural and Archaeological Research Database (SHAARD), a photograph of the bridge prior to the railing replacement shows that the bridge had rusticated stone railing with diamond-shaped cutouts (see https://secure.in.gov/apps/dnr/shaard/r/1648/N/HB2641a.jpg), similar to the railing as seen on both the 39th Street Bridge over Fall Creek and the Southern Avenue Bridge over Bean Creek. We note that INDOT standard railing type TX will be used to replace the existing, non-historic railing. This railing is obviously different from the historic stone railing as shown in the photograph. However, in contrast to the existing, metal railing, the proposed railing is somewhat more sympathetic to the design of typical early 20th century bridge railing. While we wonder if there could be any modifications made to the proposed design that would closer approximate the original design of the railing, such as modifying the bridge railing windows to a diamond shape, in taking into consideration the significance of the bridge and its character defining features, we do not object to the design as proposed.

Based on the information provided to our office, we do not believe the characteristics that qualify the above identified historic property for inclusion in the National Register will be diminished as a result of this project.

Therefore, we concur with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' January 30, 2023, finding that there are no historic buildings, structures, districts, objects, or archaeological resources within the area of potential effects that will be adversely affected by the above indicated project.



\$80K emergency repair of bridge north of Bloomington OK'd by county commissioners

At their regular Wednesday morning meeting, Monroe County commissioners approved a \$79,725 contract with CLR, Inc to fix a hole in the bridge on Bus SR 37 (aka North Walnut Street), just south of the on-ramp to I-69.

The bridge spans Beanblossom Creek.

The emergency work is expected to be done sometime in mid-August.

Of the three companies contacted by Monroe County's highway department, CLR, Inc. was the only company to provide a quote. The other two companies that were asked for a quote were Force Construction and Ragle, Inc.

According the meeting information packet, those two companies were not able to give quotes, due to their current workload.

Highway director Lisa Ridge confirmed to The B Square that the steel plate that has been laid over the hole—marked with orange barrels and indicated on the bridge's approach for drivers with signage reading "BUMP"—is a temporary measure, not the emergency fix.

Based on a letter from CLR's Chad Reitmeyer, even CLR Inc. will be hard-pressed to fit the work into its schedule. Reitmeyer wrote: "[O]ur crews are extremely busy right now and we will have to find a time to do this work, once all the preparatory work is complete, that will allow us to devote the time and resources that it will take to complete it in a short amount of time."

Reitmeyer's letter continues, "I anticipate that we would be able to complete this work in mid-August, prior to IU returning to school, and should be able to work in conjunction with our Bridge #45 that we have under contract with you located right up the road."

Bridge #45, which Reitmeyer mentions in his letter, is known as Bridge 5300034 in the National Bridge Inventory (NBI) database. It is located on the east-west running Bayles Road over Griffy Creek, about 1.2 miles south of the bridge that needs an emergency repair,


At Wednesday's meeting, Ridge told county commissioners that INDOT permits will be needed, because the repair will require closing the exit ramp off I-69 for about a week. Ridge said the bridge will likely be submitted to INDOT as a proposed bridge replacement project.

The bridge that needs an emergency repair is #913 in the county's system, but is known as Bridge 5300130 in the National Bridge Inventory (NBI) database.

Based on the 2022 numbers in the NBI, Bridge #913—the bridge that's now in need of emergency repair—has a condition rating of "fair."

Of the 231 Monroe County bridges in the NBI, 146 have condition ratings of "good", 80 are "fair" and 5 are "poor." In the maps provided with this article, bridges with "good" ratings are shown in green, those with "fair" ratings in orange, and those with "poor" ratings in red.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, LOUISVILLE DISTRICT, THE INDIANA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER, AND POSEY COUNTY INDIANA HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

REGARDING PROPOSED REMOVAL OF POSEY COUNTY BRIDGE 211 POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA LRL-2022-0217-jws

WHEREAS, the Posey County, Indiana Highway Department (Applicant) has submitted a Department of the Army (DA) Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA) permit application to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Regulatory Division (Corps) for impacts to jurisdictional waters of the U.S. (undertaking) associated with the proposed relocation and replacement of Posey County Bridge 211 (Bridge); and

WHEREAS, removal of the Bridge would require a DA Permit (LRL-2022-0217-jws) for permanent impacts to Wolf Creek associated with placement of rip rap, and temporary impacts to Wolf Creek associated with construction of a cofferdam, water pump-around system, and temporary construction dikes, and the Corps has defined the undertaking's Permit Area pursuant to 33 CFR Part 325 Appendix C as the impacts to jurisdictional waters and the work in the uplands; and

WHEREAS, the Corps has coordinated the cultural resources review pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (NHPA), as amended (54 USC 300101 et seq.: Historic Preservation; formerly 16 U.S.C. 470f)); and

WHEREAS, the Bridge, a circa 1917 single-span, metal Warren pony through-truss, has been determined to meet the criteria for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP), under Criterion C and has been designated a "Select" bridge according to the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) Historic Bridges Inventory; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant proposes to remove the bridge from its current location and replace it with a new bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Corps has consulted with the Indiana Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology/State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and the Applicant pursuant to 36 C.F.R. Part 800, regulations implementing the NHPA; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 36 C.F.R. §800.5(d)(2) and 33 C.F.R. §325, Appendix C(7)(d), and the Interim Guidance issued by the Corps on 25 April 2005, the Corps has determined that the proposed undertaking would have a direct Adverse Effect on the Bridge and the SHPO has concurred with the Adverse Effect finding; and

WHEREAS, the Corps invited the following federally recognized Native American Tribes (Tribes) to consult on the proposed undertaking: Miami Tribe, Eastern Shawnee, Shawnee, Absentee Shawnee, Delaware Tribe, Delaware Nation, Wyandotte Nation, Pokagon Band of Potawatomi, Forest County Potawatomi, Hannahville Indian Community, Gun Lake Tribe Potawatomi, Nottawaseppi Huron Band of Potawatomi, the Prairie Band of Potawatomi, and the Ouapaw Nation; and

WHEREAS, no Tribes accepted the invitation to consult; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has participated in the development of this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and been invited to sign the MOA;

WHEREAS, Indiana Landmarks, Indiana Historic Spans Task Force, Historic Hoosier Bridges, and the City of Mount Vernon, Indiana have participated in the development of the MOA and have been invited to concur in the MOA; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 800.6(a)(1), the Corps has notified the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) of its Adverse Effect determination, provided the specified documentation, and the ACHP has chosen not to participate in the consultation pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 800.6(a)(1)(iii);

NOW, THEREFORE, the Corps and the SHPO agree that the project shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties, and further agree that these stipulations shall govern the undertaking and all of its parts.

Stipulations

Applicant compliance with the following stipulations will be a condition of the DA Permit. The Applicant must fully complete all stipulations prior to the MOA expiration date as outlined below in Stipulation VII.

I. DOCUMENTATION AND RELOCATION OF POSEY COUNTY BRIDGE 211

- A. Prior to removing the Bridge, the Applicant will contract with a Secretary of the Interior (SOI)-qualified cultural resources consultant to document the Bridge in accordance with Indiana DNR Division of Historic Preservation and Archaeology Minimum Architectural Documentation Standards. Bridge removal should be documented as well. Documentation will include:
 - 1. Digital photo documentation of the Bridge that shows its architectural and structural elements, surrounding environmental settings, views from each approach, and any other significant character-defining details. Digital photo documentation of the bridge removal process. Digital, color photographs in .TIF format, a photo log that corresponds to the photographs, a photo key, and an overview thumbnail sheet of the photographs will be provided on CD, flash drive, or any other previously approved storage device or online transfer method.
 - a. If available, a copy of the original construction plans will be included in the documentation.
 - b. The Applicant will submit a digital draft of the completed documentation to the Corps for distribution to the SHPO and Consulting Parties for review and comment. The Corps, SHPO, and Consulting Parties will provide comments within 30 calendar days of receipt.
 - c. The Applicant will ensure that its consultant incorporates the comments, as appropriate, into the revised design and provide it to the Corps for distribution to the SHPO and Consulting Parties within thirty (30) days of receipt of comments.
 - i. Upon notification by the Corps of acceptance of the documentation, the Applicant will provide a copy to the SHPO for upload to the State

Historic Architectural and Archaeological Research Database and transferal to the Indiana State Archives.

- d. Within 30 days of completion of the bridge removal, the qualified professional shall prepare a short report documenting the results of the bridge removal and submit it to the Corps.
 - i. Upon receipt, the Corps will distribute the report to the SHPO and Consulting Parties.
- 2. Prior to putting the project out for bid, the Applicant will provide a copy of the construction plans to the SHPO and Consulting Parties for review and comment.
 - a. The SHPO and consulting parties will provide comments on the construction plans within 30 days of receipt. The Applicant will incorporate the comments into the bid solicitation document as appropriate.
- 3. As a primary mitigation action, the Applicant intends to relocate the Bridge to the City of Mount Vernon, Indiana per the letter of intent submitted by City of Mount Vernon Mayor G. William Curtis and included here as Appendix A. The Bridge will be permanently and accurately re-assembled in accordance with the SOI Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties; the Applicant or the Applicant's SOI qualified contractor shall be responsible for the following:
 - a. Submit the methodology for disassembling, transporting and reassembling the Bridge to the Corps, SHPO, and consulting parties for review prior to processing with any disassembly of the structure or demolition of the site. The SHPO shall have thirty (30) days to comment on the proposed disassembly/reassembly plan. If a response is not received within 30 days of the submission, the plan shall be approved.
 - b. Oversee the removal and numbering of each bridge member to ensure the bridge can be properly reassembled. The pieces shall be matchmarked prior to disassembly.
 - c. All truss members shall be salvaged for re-use with the following exceptions:
 - 1. Any members documented with a condition rating of 1 "Imminent" Failure Condition or 0 Failed Condition in accordance with the FHWA Recording and Coding Guide for the Structure Inventory and Appraisal of the Nation's Bridges.
 - i. Members not salvaged for re-use will be replaced in-kind.
 - d. The substructure, including the concrete abutments and wingwalls, will not be salvaged for re-use.
 - e. The Bridge will be relocated to Brittle Bank Park in Mount Vernon to be utilized as a pedestrian bridge over a stream as part of a planned trail corridor expansion.
 - 1. Prior to the construction of a new substructure and reassembly of the Bridge in Brittle Bank Park the Applicant will submit the relocation and rehabilitation plans to the Corps, SHPO and Consulting Parties. The Corps, SHPO and Consulting Parties will have thirty (30) days to comment on this notification. The Corps and SHPO will also notify the Applicant if a Phase Ia archaeological survey will be required at the new bridge location.

- i. If an archaeological survey is required the applicant will contract with an SOI-qualified archaeological consultant to conduct the survey in accordance with Secretary of the Interior's *Standards and Guidelines for Archeology and Historic Preservation* and in accordance with Indiana State regulations IC 14-21-1, the Guidebook for Indiana Historic Sites and Structures Inventory—Archaeological sites, 312 IAC 21, and 312 IAC 22.
- ii. If evidence of archaeological sites, such as prehistoric or historic artifacts and/or features is identified, the archaeological consultant can assess the site and consult with the Corps and the SHPO regarding the potential NRHP-eligibility of the site and if further investigation will be required.
- f. If the Bridge elements need to be temporarily stored prior to relocation, the Applicant will ensure that they are temporarily stored in a location where they are protected from rain, snow, groundwater, and theft until such time as the Bridge is reassembled.
 - 1. The period of temporary storage will not exceed two (2) years.
 - 2. The Applicant or an entity contracted by the Applicant will be responsible for transportation of the bridge to and from storage as required.
 - 3. The Applicant will be responsible for care and maintenance of the Bridge until such time as ownership of the bridge is transferred to the City of Mount Vernon. Within 30 days of transferring the bridge to Mount Vernon, the Applicant will provide documentation of the transfer to the Corps and SHPO.

II. ADDITIONAL MITIGATION

- A. The Applicant will contract with an SOI-qualified cultural resources consultant to develop an interpretive sign to be placed near the reassembled Bridge in Brittle Bank Park. The sign should discuss the history of the Bridge, including its original location and relocation efforts. It should also include information on truss-type bridges or a QR code linking to information about the history of truss bridges;
 - 1. Within twelve (12) months of permit issuance, the Applicant's consultant will provide proposed design and text for the interpretive sign to the Corps. The Corps will distribute the proposal to SHPO and other Consulting Parties for review and comment. A map showing the proposed location of the signage will be submitted with the proposed text.
 - 2. The Corps, SHPO and Consulting Parties will provide comments on the design and text within 30 business days of receipt. The Corps will compile all comments and provide them to the Applicant. The Applicant will ensure that its consultant

incorporates the comments, as appropriate, into the revised design and provide it to the Corps within thirty (30) days of receipt of comments.

- 3. Within 30 calendar days of installation of the sign, the Applicant will provide the Corps and SHPO with photographs showing the reassembled bridge and the installed sign.
- B. After the Bridge has been relocated and reassembled, the Applicant or the Applicant's SOI-qualified cultural resources consultant will provide the Corps and SHPO with photographs showing the Bridge in its new location and its relation to the stream, and a brief description of the percentage of original truss members and floor structure members that were reused in the reassembly of the Bridge.
 - 1. Within thirty (30) days of receipt of the photographs of the bridge and its setting, the Indiana SHPO will respond with an opinion on whether or not the bridge is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.
 - 2. If the bridge is determined to be eligible, the Applicant will contract with an SOI-qualified cultural resources consultant to prepare a NRHP nomination form within 90 days after the Bridge has been relocated to the new location over the stream in Brittle Bank Park.
 - 3. The Applicant will submit the draft NRHP nomination form to SHPO for review and comment. The Applicant or its SOI-qualified consultant will use forms provided by the SHPO and comply with all applicable National Park Service guidelines. The application will include all necessary maps and images.
 - 4. The SHPO will process the National Register application in accordance with the SHPO National Register policy. The technical review will be conducted by the SHPO within thirty (30) days. Once the application has passed technical review, it will be placed in the substantive review queue. The Applicant will respond to requests for additional documentation or editorial changes for both technical review and substantive review. The Applicant will incorporate the revisions and provide additional information or a redraft within 60 days of receipt of comments. Note that the queue for substantive review may require the Applicant to wait for their turn for approximately twenty (20) months from the time of technical review approval. Once deemed complete, SHPO staff will schedule the National Register application for the next possible meeting of the Indiana Historic Preservation Review Board to be approved.
 - a. Once the application has been approved by the Indiana Historic Preservation Review Board, the SHPO will notify the Corps and this stipulation will be considered complete.

III. POST REVIEW DISCOVERY

- A. If, during the implementation of the undertaking a previously unidentified cultural resource is encountered, the Applicant will ensure that the construction contractor stops work within 100 feet of the newly identified cultural resource and immediately notify the Corps.
- B. Upon notification of a previously unknown resource, the Corps will notify the SHPO and consult with the SHPO and the Applicant to evaluate the newly identified resource and/or develop an appropriate treatment plan, as necessary, pursuant to 36 C.F.R. Part 800, and the Secretary of the

Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Archeology and Historic Preservation and in accordance with Indiana State regulations IC 14-21-1, the Guidebook for Indiana Historic Sites and Structures Inventory—Archaeological sites, 312 IAC 21, and 312 IAC 22.

C. If human remains are discovered during the undertaking, the Applicant will immediately stop work within 100 feet of the find and notify the Posey County Coroner and the Corps. The Corps will notify the SHPO. If the remains are determined to be Native American, the Corps will consult with Native American Tribes with an interest in the area regarding the disposition of the remains. Remains determined to be of a criminal nature or non-Native American will be treated in accordance with all applicable State and local laws.

IV. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- A. Should any signatory, invited signatory, or concurring party object at any time in writing to the Corps regarding any action carried out or proposed with respect to the Undertaking or to the manner in which the terms of this MOA are implemented, the Corps shall consult with such party to resolve the objection. The Corps shall also notify the other signatories to this MOA of such objection and provide them the opportunity to participate in any consultations to resolve the objection. If the Corps determines that such objection cannot be resolved, the Corps will:
 - 1. Forward all documentation relevant to the dispute, including the Corps' proposed resolution, to the ACHP. The ACHP shall provide the Corps with its advice on the resolution of the objection within thirty (30) days of receiving adequate documentation. Prior to reaching a final decision on the dispute, the Corps shall prepare a written response that takes into account any timely advice or comments regarding the dispute from the ACHP, signatories, and concurring parties, and provide them with a copy of this written response.
 - 2. If the ACHP does not provide its advice regarding the dispute within the thirty (30)-day time period, the Corps may make a final decision on the dispute and proceed accordingly. Prior to reaching such a final decision, the Corps shall prepare a written response that takes into account any timely comments regarding the dispute from the signatories and concurring parties to the MOA, and provide them and the ACHP with a copy of such written response.

The Corps will then proceed with its final decision.

B. The Corps' responsibility to carry out all other actions subject to the terms of this MOA that are not the subject of the dispute remains unchanged.

V. TERMINATION

A. If the Corps determines that the terms of this agreement cannot be implemented as stipulated or a signatory determines that the agreement is not being properly implemented, such party may propose to the other signatories to the agreement that it be terminated in accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 800.6 (c)(1) and (8).

- B. The party proposing to terminate this agreement shall so notify all parties to this agreement, including the concurring parties, explaining the reasons for termination and affording the parties at least thirty (30) days to consult and seek alternatives to termination. The parties shall then consult.
- C. If, after the expiration of thirty (30) days an agreement to avoid termination cannot be reached, the Corps or other signatory (including invited signatories who sign) may terminate this agreement by notifying all parties in writing.
- D. Should this agreement be terminated, the Corps shall either:
 - 1. Consult with all parties in accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 800.6 to develop a new MOA: or
 - 2. Request the comments of the ACHP pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 800.7.

VI. AMENDMENTS

A. Any signatory (including invited signatories) to this agreement may propose to the Corps that the agreement be amended, whereupon the Corps shall consult with the other parties to this agreement to consider such an amendment. The execution of any such agreement shall be governed by 36 C.F.R. § 800.6(c)(1). The signatures of all of the signatories shall be required for any amendment to take effect.

VII. DURATION

A. If the DA Permit is not issued, this MOA will be considered null and void. If the Applicant cannot fully implement the terms of this MOA within 24 months of the date the DA Permit was issued, the Applicant will notify the Corps in writing at CELRL.Door.To.The.Corps@usace.army.mil 60 days before the expiration date of the MOA. The

Corps, prior to the expiration of the 24-month term, will consult with the SHPO, Invited Signatory, and concurring parties to reconsider the terms of the MOA, including the time limit, and amend it in accordance with Stipulation VI above.

- B. This MOA shall be effective upon signature of all Signatories and filing with ACHP and shall remain in effect until the earliest of the following occurs: the 24-month implementation period has expired, or the MOA is amended or terminated and replaced.
- C. Execution of this MOA and implementation of its terms shall evidence that the Corps has afforded the ACHP an opportunity to comment on the proposed Undertaking and its effects on historic properties, and that the Corps has taken into account the effects of the Undertaking on historic properties.

Dear Mr. Collins:

The City of Mount Vernon (the City) has recently been awarded a grant through the Indiana Regional Economic + Acceleration Development Initiative (READI) which will allow for the expansion of a trail project through Brittle Bank Park. The City has developed preliminary plans for the trail project and has identified two locations along the trail corridor where an approximate 65' total length bridge will be required. Knowing that the Posey County Board of Commissioners is in the design phase of a bridge project (Bridge 211 on Wildeman Road), whereas the existing superstructure is considered a Select Historic bridge, it is anticipated that this bridge has surpassed its service life as a vehicular bridge but could now be used as a pedestrian bridge with a lower structural capacity. As such, the City hereby expresses that we have a desired interest to receive the existing Select Historic bridge and utilize it as a pedestrian bridge on the upcoming trail corridor expansion project going through Brittle Bank Park, located in Mount Vernon, Indiana (Posey County, IN), should it prove to not be cost prohibitive.

The City understands that the Posey County Board of Commissioners has completed a Plan of Action for relocation of the Select Historic bridge for the US Army Corps of Engineers, and as part of the plan, the Select Historic bridge is to be transported and stored at the local Highway Department yard for up to 24 months. Should the Posey County Board of Commissioners be authorized to relocate the Select Historic bridge, it is the intent of the City to take ownership of the Select Historic bridge and receive delivery of this bridge by Fall 2023, which is well within the 24 months stipulated in the Relocation Plan of Action. The City shall not diminish the historic integrity of the Select Bridge once it is received and installed.
