INDOT Annual Performance Measures CY 2025 Safety Target Declaration\* (updated August 30, 2024 by the Manager of the INDOT Office of Traffic Safety) (<a href="https://www.nhtsa.gov/highway-safety-grants-program/state-performancetargets">https://www.nhtsa.gov/highway-safety-grants-program/state-performancetargets</a>): We've received a revised set of targets from INDOT to re-approve it's due to the slower than previously anticipated growth in traffic. These targets are required by congress as part of USDOT, Federal Highway etc agencies. The new targets are showing a 2% reduction over the 24-year period. INDOT's projections reflect the goals of the Department of Transportation and require approval by the committee. If INDOT fails to meet the goals, there will be a penalty there will be a reduction in surface transportation block grant funds (the largest source of funding for projects in this state) and increase funding (redirect funds) for highway safety improvement program projects (aka a higher investment in safety).
