RE: TIP Change Request

Per the new TIP change standards, a change in project cost for a local project, using Non-MPO funds can be processed by Policy Board through an email vote. A quorum must agree for the resolution to be passed. No response is considered an abstain. As a reminder, any Policy Board member may request that the proposed Amendment be referred to the next Policy Board meeting for consideration.

### **Request Summary:**

Danny Hollander received a grant for the Lowell Road Bridge and intersection with CR 325 West. This project uses Non-MPO federal funds. (This is funded separately from Lowell Road Phase 1: Lowell Road between CR 325 W and Columbus City Limits, which does use MPO funds and is slated for FY 2028.) This County project has increased in cost. However, at this time, no additional federal funds have been granted. Therefore, the local match has increased. Mr. Hollander was notified by INDOT that the TIP needs to be updated to reflect the cost increase and therefore the local match increase. The table below shows the original and new costs for the different phases of the project per Mr. Hollander's updated estimates.
