WHEREAS, all projects included in *Amendment 7 – Fiscal Years 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program* are exempt from transportation conformity requirements for air quality; and

WHEREAS, the opportunity for public participation has been provided per OKI's Public Participation Plan with a public review period from March 25, 2026 through April 8, 2026; and
