- This project will add travel lanes, access management, and pedestrian infrastructure along US 36 and SR 9 in Pendleton, Madison County.
- The purpose of the project is to reduce travel delay, improve pedestrian and bicycle accessibility and connectivity, and improve safety by reducing conflict points.
- As proposed, the project involves construction of additional vehicular travel lanes along US 36 and SR 9 from Madison Avenue to the bridge over Fall Creek and additional turn lanes at the intersection of US 36 and SR 38 and the intersection of US 36 and SR 9. In addition, sidewalk and shared-use path with amenities such as lighting and benches, is proposed along US 36, State Street, SR 38, and Hayden Way as part of this project. Access management using raised medians is proposed along US 36, State Street, and SR 38.
