



Wabash Bridge Frequently Asked Questions

What has happened?

Effective July 1, 2014, the State of Indiana discontinued tolls on the Wabash Bridge in Posey County, Ind. This decision came after INDOT evaluated the tolling revenues associated with the bridge, and cost to the state to operate and maintain the structure.

How did INDOT make this determination?

INDOT considered many factors in its evaluation, such as the volume of traffic, and the cost to maintain and operate the bridge versus the cost to continue tolling. After this careful evaluation, INDOT believed this was the right decision regarding this particular bridge.

How will this change affect Wabash Pass account holders?

Beginning July 1, 2014, motorists no longer need to have a vehicle transponder or Wabash Pass Internet account to use the bridge. Wabash Pass holders who have a positive account balance after July 1 will receive full refunds.

Will motorists need to pay past due tolls or penalties?

Yes. INDOT will continue collection efforts for those who are now in collection or who owe tolls accrued prior to July 1. Unpaid balances will be turned over to a collection agency after July 31.

How can I check my account balance or pay accrued tolls?

Account holders can verify their account balance, pay outstanding charges, and confirm their mailing address for refunds by calling (toll free) 1-866-849-1368. Account payments can be mailed to:
