**ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER**

**TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, GREETINGS**

WHEREAS: The River Road Scenic Byway in Tippecanoe County was previously designated a state byway by Order of the Commissioner and with support of the Lieutenant Governor in June 2008; and

WHEREAS: The Indiana Office of Tourism Development, the Indiana Department of Natural Resources and the Indiana Department of Transportation worked cooperatively to achieve the June 2008 designation; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Commissioners for Tippecanoe County has now recommended that the River Road Scenic Byway be renamed the Wabash River Scenic Byway to more effectively identify and celebrate the Wabash River, which the Byway serves to commemorate and this name change follows the intent of the original designation application titled "River Road Scenic Byway (initial phase of the Wabash River Scenic Byway)"; now Therefore,

In response to the recommendation of the Board of Commissioners for Tippecanoe County and with the support of other local agencies in the Lafayette-West Lafayette area, the name "River Road Scenic Byway" is changed to "Wabash River Scenic Byway" by this Order of the Commissioner, and the designated route description is updated to reflect the completion of US 231 around West Lafayette and relinquishment of former SR 43 (North River Road) to the City of West Lafayette and Tippecanoe County. This Order of the Commissioner follows the same route as the June 2008 designation but has been updated to remove references to US 231 and SR 43 as follows:

**BE IT RESOLVED BY ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER**


SECTION 1: Beginning at Ross Hills County Park and traveling north on Tippecanoe CR 875 West to the intersection with Division Road and then proceeding east to South River Road and following South River Road to its intersection with State Street.

SECTION 2: Beginning from South River Road at State Street and proceeding on North River Road (former SR 43) to the interchange with I-65 and SR 43 North where the Wabash River Scenic Byway will terminate.

SECTION 3: Appropriate signs shall be designed and installed in accordance with current standards as determined by the Department of Transportation.
