INVESTMENT MANAGERS

Galliard Capital Management is the Fund's Advisor. Effective 1/3/17, the Fund's portfolio management strategy is to employ multiple investment managers as co-managers to benefit from the diversity of investment approaches and as a risk mitigation tool. From time to time, investment managers may be re-evaluated and replaced. In addition to Galliard, the current subadvisors used within the Fund are IR&M, Jennison, Dodge & Cox, and TCW.

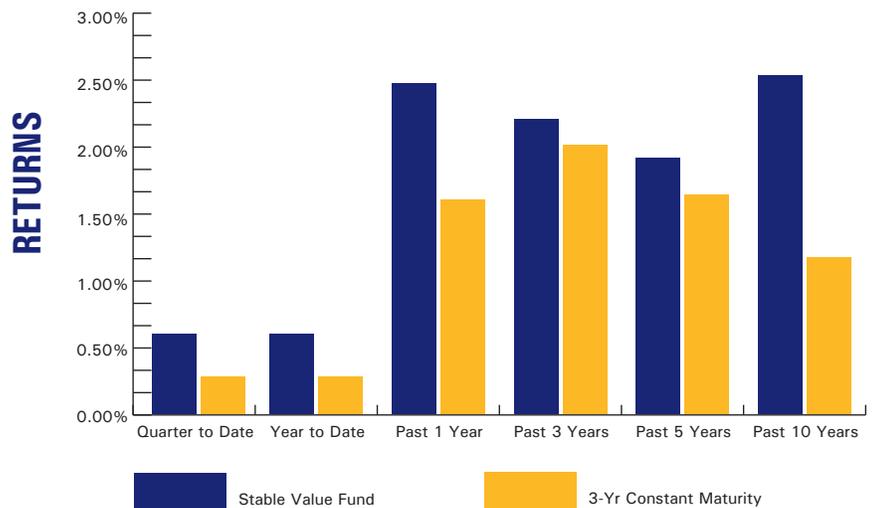
