



## IOT NDA and ISF Access

To do business with the State of Indiana, vendors must adhere to the policies and enterprise standards that collectively constitute the Indiana Office of Technology's Information Security Framework (ISF). Vendors must complete a non-disclosure agreement to access IOT's ISF.

To request and secure access to IOT's Information Security Framework (ISF), vendors should complete the following steps:

- Create an Access Indiana account for **each** individual requiring access to the ISF. Shared mailboxes are not recommended and NDAs submitted with shared mailboxes may be denied.

- After creating the Access Indiana account and while remaining logged into Access Indiana, complete IOT's online [Non-Disclosure Agreement \(NDA\)](#), located here: <https://in.accessgov.com/iot/Forms/Page/iot/iot-nda/>
  - Note that the Access Indiana login account **must be the same** as the email address provided on the NDA form for each individual needing access to the ISF.
- After signing and submitting the online NDA, IOT will review the submitted form and verify approval to access the [ISF webpage](#), located here (authentication required for access): <https://www.in.gov/iot/policies-procedures-and-standards/>
- After receiving electronic verification of approval, vendors can then access the ISF webpage to download the Indiana Statewide IT policies, review the list of individual Enterprise Standardized Technologies, and review the individual technology standards that apply to the product or service being provided to the State of Indiana.
- Responses to NDA submissions should be expected within 3 business days.

After receiving notice that the NDA has been approved, complete the following steps to ensure access.

1. Open an incognito browser window.
2. Navigate to <https://access.in.gov> and log in to your Access Indiana account.
3. Navigate to the [policies page \(https://www.in.gov/iot/policies-procedures-and-standards/\)](https://www.in.gov/iot/policies-procedures-and-standards/) and access should be automatically granted.
4. **Note that the Access Indiana login account email must be the same as the email address provided on the NDA form for each individual needing access to the ISF policies page.**
