The Marshall County Prosecutor's Office seeks to fill one position as Deputy Prosecuting Attorney. The office consists of five prosecutors including of course the elected and Chief Deputy. Deputy Prosecutors are responsible for reviewing case reports, interviewing witnesses, assisting law enforcement, preparing and filing court documents, preparing for and conducting court hearings and bench or jury trials. 2026 salary set at \$106,911.63. The proposed 2027 salary is \$110,118.98.

This DPA position is currently vacant and immediately available. The application period will remain open until filled.

Qualifications include a Juris Doctorate degree and an Indiana license to practice law in Good Standing. Applicant must possess a valid driver's license.
