This one-day trial advocacy course will teach inexperienced prosecutors how to use the Indiana Rules of Evidence. Students will attend lectures on the rules and then immediately put them to use solving evidentiary problems in the case of *State v. Zeb Jones*. Learn relevancy, hearsay and foundations to get your evidence in. Course materials will be provided prior to training. Students will be expected to be familiar with the provided case file and be prepared to participate in mock trial exercises. This course is designed for the deputy prosecutor with little experience using the Indiana Rules of Evidence.
